NOTICE OF RACE

The Ida Lewis Yacht Club (ILYC), the organizing authority, invites members and associates of the International Etchells class to the 2014 Etchells Pre-Worlds Regatta.

1.0 RULES:

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the "Rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The following prescriptions of US Sailing will apply: Rules 40, 61.4, 67, 76.1, and Appendix R only.
- 1.3 The Regatta is classified as "Open Events" under Appendix "A" of the International Etchells Class rules, except that all skippers are required to be current members of the International Etchells Class Association.
- 1.4 Advertising is restricted to the Etchells class rules Category A under ISAF Regulation 20. The organizing authority may require all boats to display the event sponsor's advertising in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.4.1.1
- 1.5 The International Etchells Class Rules are changed as follows: All competing boats shall carry a hand held VHF radio for safety purposes, and race committee communication.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 2.1 The regatta series is open to all boats of the International Etchells Class.
- 2.2 Boats may register for the Regatta by going to the regatta web site (http://www.ilyc.org/etchells_pre_worlds.html) and following the instructions. Late registrations will be accepted

3.0 ENTRY FEES:

- 3.1 The Early Entry: If paid in full on or before April 30, 2014 the entry fee is \$300 per boat with a crew of 3 or \$325 per boat with a crew of 4.
- 3.2 If paid in full after April 30, 2014, the entry fee is \$350 per boat with a crew of 3 and \$375 per boat with a crew of 4.
- 3.3 The entry fee includes the fee for all social events at Ida Lewis Yacht Club, including the Registration Party on Friday, June 6th, the Ida Lewis Event on Saturday, June 7th, and the Awards Party on Sunday, June 8th

3.4 Storage, Trailer Storage, Hoist Services and Dockage Fees:

- A) The Entry Fee **does not** include storage, launch/haul nor dockage. Boats wishing to launch/haul, dock, and store at Sail Newport during this event only will be subject to an additional \$110 fee to be paid at the time of registration. Boats may arrive after June 4 and must depart prior to 1700 on June 9.
- B) For boats wishing to attend this event and store through the World Championship hosted by New York Yacht Club in June, Sail Newport is offering exclusive storage packages. Long term storage arrangements with Sail Newport include unlimited launching and hauling as well as dockage. Boats making such arrangements will not be subject to an additional launch/haul, dockage, and storage fees for this event (the \$110 listed above). 4.0 SCHEDULE:

4.1 Friday, June 6, 2014

1500-1900 Registration at Ida Lewis Yacht Club

Saturday, June 7, 2014

O830 Skippers Meeting at the Admiral's Dock (near Sail Newport)

0900 Rendezvous Area Signal

Warning Signal for the first race. Additional race(s) to follow ASAP.
 Post Race gathering and Buffet Dinner at Ida Lewis Yacht Club

Sunday, June 8, 2014

0900 Rendezvous Area Signal

1100 Warning Signal for the first race. Additional race(s) to follow ASAP.

1700 Awards at Ida Lewis Yacht Club

- **4.2** A total of five races are scheduled. On Sunday, June 8, 2014 no Initial Warning Signal may be made after 1400. The Warning Signal for a start following one or more General Recalls may be made after 1400.
- **5.0 CREW WEIGH- IN AND MEASURMENT:** No Boat, Rig Or Sail Measurement, Or Crew Weights Will Be Officially Taken.
- **6.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The Sailing instructions will be available at Registration, at the skipper's meeting, as well as being posted on the regatta website (http://www.ilyc.org/etchells_pre_worlds.html) prior to the first race.

7.0 Venue and Racing Area:

- 7.1 Racing will be held in the waters of Rhode Island Sound and/or Narragansett Bay.
- 7.2 Regatta headquarters will be at Ida Lewis Yacht Club
- **8.0 COURSES:** The race course configuration will be Windward–Leeward with offset marks, and gates.

9.0 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 9.1 A boat that may have broken a rule of Part 2 outside the zone of any rounding or finishing mark, may take a One-Turn Penalty. For a boat that may have broken a rule of Part 2 within the zone of any rounding or finishing mark, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty This changes rule 44.1.
- 9.2 The penalty, if any, for a violation of a rule other than a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 will be at discretion of the Protest Committee and may be other than disqualification. This changes rule 64.1(a).

10.0 SCORING: The Low Point scoring system, *Rule* A2, will apply, except a boat's score will be the total of her race scores. (This changes *Rules* A2.)

- 11.0 PRIZES: The top three boats will be awarded prizes.
- **12.0 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS:** All boats shall be afloat before 0800 on June 7 and are to remain in the water for the duration of the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the Principal Race Officer or Protest Committee.
- 13.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY: The safety of a boat and her entire management shall be the sole inescapable responsibility of the owner/owners' representative. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk.. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- **14.0 MANDATORY INSURANCE:** Each boat is required to carry current Third Party Liability insurance of not less than US \$300,000. All insurance coverage shall be valid in the US and maintained during the period of racing. It is the owner's or owners' representative's sole and inescapable responsibility to ensure that the insurance is in place prior to participating in this event. **Proof of insurance shall be supplied with each entry**.

15.0 SUPPORT BOATS:

- 15.1 Support and coach boats shall register with the race committee prior to the skippers meeting. Support boats may be given an identifying flag. The identifying flag shall be flown at all times during the regatta(s). All support boats are required to monitor VHF 72 during the regattas and respond promptly to all Race Committee or Organizing Authority directives. Additional rules pertaining to support boats may be supplied with the Sailing Instructions.
- 15.2 Support Boats shall remain 500 feet outside all lay lines and above/below the all marks of the course at all times while boats are racing.
