1. RULES

- 1.1 The U.S. Sailing Association's Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 edition will govern this regatta.
- 1.2 US Sailing Racing Rule 52 is modified so that a Brenta 38 may use hydraulics for their mainsail only.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2. 1 All competitors must:
 - **2.1 a** Be members in good standing of Breakwater Yacht Club.
 - **2.1b** Have paid the entry fee.
 - 2.1c Have boat insurance covering racing.
 - 2.1 d Hold a valid ELIYA PHRF 2020 certificate
- 2.2 Visiting boats may enter at a cost of \$20.00 per individual race but will not be scored for the series.
- 2.2 Eligibility to race for visiting boats is up to the discretion of the Regatta Committee.
- 2.3 No competitor will be scored without fulfilling all eligibility requirements prior to the race.

3. <u>FEES</u>

- 3.1 \$190 for US Sailing Members
- 3.2 \$195 for non-US Sailing members
- 3.3 All fees must be paid through BYC Summer series Yachtscoring Summer 2020

4. DIVISIONS

- 4.1 Division I: Spinnaker boats having PHRF of 95 or less and rated with an Asymmetric Spin
- 4.2 Division II: Spinnaker boats having PHRF of 96 or more <u>or</u> rated with a Symmetric Spin
- 4.3 Division III: Non-Spinnaker boats
- 4.4 Division IV: J70 One-Design
- 4.5 The Race Committee reserves the right to classify certain boats as it sees fit.

5. COURSES

- 5.1 All races will be run in ShelterIsland Sound.
- 5.2 Courses will be displayed from a board on the committee boat.

6. START

The start shall be in the area west of Majors Cove in Shelter Island Sound. The RC shall attempt to sound the first gun at 6:00 PM local time.

7. SCORING

- 7.1 For each division, the low point scoring system (U.S. Sailing rules Appendix A using A9 modified to count DNS, DNF, RAF, DSQ, and OSC as scored equal to the number of series boats coming to the starting area and keeping DNC scored as 1 more than the number of boats entered in the series) will be used.
- 7.2 A boat's best scores for 70% of the races run, rounded normally to a whole number, will be counted to score the series.
- 7.3 Penalties are applied to the Time Correction Factor (TCF) for last year's 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place finishers in each division, excluding Division IV.

8. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in each division with at least 3 boats entered there.

9. CHANGES

Changes to the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions may be posted on the official notice board at the BYC Clubhouse and/or on the BYC website: <u>Yachtscoring Summer 2020</u> Skippers may also be notified by email.

10. WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INJURY

Competitors participate in the series entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Breakwater Yacht Club, Organizing Authority, Sponsors, Support Facilities, Volunteers, Agents, Employees and Service providers, the PRO and the Committee will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Regatta for both on-the-water and on-land activities. By participating in this event, each competitor (owners, skippers, and crews) agrees to release the race organizers and all persons and groups listed above from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
