## NOTICE OF RACE

with Amendment Nos. 1, 2, and 3

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 Racing shall be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The notation "**[NP]**" in a rule in this Notice of Race means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).
- 1.3 **[DP] [NP]** Eastport Yacht Club (EYC) recommends that each competitor review and prepare their boat to the U.S. Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements, Nearshore. A copy of the Nearshore requirements is available at <http://eastportyc.org/racing>, located under "Racing Resources."

### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 There will be three classes: Non-Spinnaker, Spinnaker, and Harbor 20.
- 2.2 Online registration is available at the EYC website <http://eastportyc.org/leftover-bowl>.

### 3 FEES

The entry fee is \$40. Paid entries must be received by 1300 hours on Friday, 27 November 2020.

### 4 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

The schedule of events is:

Sat, 28 November	1300	Intended Warning Signal for first class

### 5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the EYC website no later than Saturday, 14 November 2020, and posted on the Official Notice Board, located electronically at <http://eastportyc.org/leftover-bowl>.

### 6 VENUE

The racing area will be on the Severn River and Chesapeake Bay.

### 7 COURSE

Competitors will sail one (1) fixed mark course on the Severn River and Chesapeake Bay as described in the Sailing Instructions.

### 8 PENALTIES

- 8.1 RRS Appendix V1, Penalty at the Time of An Incident, will apply.
- 8.2 RRS Appendix V2, Penalty Taken After A Race, will apply.

### 9 SCORING

- 9.1 RRS A4, the Low Point scoring system will apply.
- 9.2 Scoring will be based on the order of finish.

### 10 RADIO COMMUNICATION

**[DP] [NP]** Competitors shall have and monitor a working VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on VHF channels 9, 13, 16, and 73.

- 11.1 A brief awards ceremony will be held on the EYC Aft deck. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place prizes will be awarded in each class. The prizes will be selected by the Race Committee from the 'treasure trove' of leftover and unclaimed trophies from previous years.
- 11.2 The EYC Golden Shoes award will be presented to the best-dressed boat/crew.
- 11.3 The rubber chicken award will be presented to the boat that finishes last.

**12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the Leftover Bowl entirely at their own risk; see RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will accept no liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

**13 INSURANCE**

**[DP] [NP]** Each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.
