## NOTICE OF RACE Amendment No. 2

To accommodate racing under the current circumstances multiple changes have been made. All are detailed immediately below.

Insert new 1.3, and renumber old 1.3 & 1.4 to be 1.4. & 1.5, respectively.

- 1.3 The notation “[DP]” in a rule in this Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the Protest Committee, be less than disqualification.
- 1.4 The notation “[NP]” in a rule in this Notice of Race means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).
- 1.5 [NP] Eastport Yacht Club (EYC) recommends that each competitor review and prepare their boat to the U.S. Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements, Nearshore. A copy of the Nearshore requirements is available at <http://eastportyc.org/racing>, located under "Racing Resources."

Insert new 1.6.

- 1.6 [DP] Participants shall abide by all local, state, and federal health and safety guidelines in effect the day of the race.

Revise the race entry fees to reflect the revised format. NoR 3.1 is replaced with the following.

- 3.1 The fee is:
  - ♦ \$50 for paid entries received by 2000 hours on Saturday, 04 July 2020.
  - ♦ \$65 for paid entries received after 2000 hours on Saturday, 04 July 2020, but before 1200 hours on Thursday, 09 July 2020.

Revise the Schedule of Events to include a skippers meeting via video teleconference, and delete the post-race social and awards presentation. NoR 4.1 is replaced with the following.

The location of the mandatory check-in has not yet been determined. NoR 4.2 is replaced with the following.

- 4.2 There will be a mandatory check-in requirement for all competitors prior to their start. The check-in location will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

Scoring for the CRCA ORREZ classes is identified. Insert new NoR 9.3.

9.3 ORREZ handicap scoring will be wind-indexed and in accordance with CRCA class rules.

The prize structure and depth has been revised. NoR 11.1 is replaced with the following.

11.1 Prizes in each class will be as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> Place for three (3) or more entries;

The post-race party and awards presentation has been eliminated this year. Prizes will still be given, and the Organizing Authority reserves the right to add additional prizes, at their discretion. NoR 11.5 is replaced with the following.

11.5 Additional awards may be presented at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

References to post-race gatherings and awards presentation at EYC were deleted from the ADDITIONAL INFORMATION section. Replace ADDITIONAL INFORMATION with the following.

- EYC will offer and recommends attendance at a night navigation & commercial traffic seminar beginning at 1900 hours on Thursday, 09 July 2020.

- Out-of-town boats that wish to berth at EYC are encouraged to contact the EYC Waterfront Director as early as possible to make the necessary arrangements ([waterfront@eastportyc.org](mailto:waterfront@eastportyc.org); (410) 267-9549). Available space will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Competitors should not assume space will be available at EYC if they do not first coordinate with the Waterfront Director.
