NOTICE OF RACE

with Amendment Nos. 1 & 2

1 RULES

- 1.1 Racing shall be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 For the J/105 Fleet, Article 9.1 through 9.1.7 of the J/105 Fleet 3 Articles shall be in effect. The J/105 Fleet 3 Articles can be found at www.j105fleet3.org/rules. This is a Level A event.
- 1.3 The notation “[DP]” in a rule in this Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the Protest Committee, be less than disqualification.
- 1.4 The notation “[NP]” in a rule in this Notice of Race means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).
- 1.5 [NP] Eastport Yacht Club (EYC) recommends that each competitor review and prepare their boat to the U.S. Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements, Nearshore. A copy of the Nearshore requirements is available at <http://eastportyc.org/racing>, located under "Racing Resources."
- 1.6 [DP] Participants shall abide by all local, state, and federal health and safety guidelines in effect the day of the race.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This race is open to boats of the following classes:

PHRF A0/A1	PHRF C	J/30	Multihull A
PHRF A2	PHRF N	J/35	Multihull B
PHRF B	Alberg 30	J/105	
CHESSS (Spinnaker; Non-Spinnaker)			
CRCA-ORR (Cruiser; Non-Spinnaker; Performance Cruiser; Racer-Cruiser)			
CRCA-ARC (Non-Spinnaker; Spinnaker)			
- 2.2 Participants competing in a handicap class shall have a valid 2020 rating certificate.
- 2.3 Online registration is available at the EYC website <http://eastportyc.org/boomerang>.
- 2.4 Additional classes will be accepted upon the receipt of six (6) or more paid entries by 2000 hours on Saturday, 04 July 2020.
- 2.5 To qualify for the Patriot Cup a boat shall sail with at least two (2) U.S. military veterans aboard. Entries sponsored by U.S. PATRIOT SAILING will not be eligible to compete for this Cup.

3 FEES

- 3.1 The fee is:
 - ♦ \$50 for paid entries received by 2000 hours on Saturday, 04 July 2020.
 - ♦ \$65 for paid entries received after 2000 hours on Saturday, 04 July 2020, but before 1200 hours on Thursday, 09 July 2020.
- 3.2 A 50% entry fee refund will be provided if a request to withdraw from the race is received by 2000 hours on Saturday, 04 July 2020.

4 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1 The schedule of events is:

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- 4.2 There will be a mandatory check-in requirement for all competitors prior to their start. The check-in location will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.
- 4.3 The starting order will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

[NP] The Sailing Instructions will be available on the EYC website no later than Thursday, 25 June 2020, and posted on the Official Notice Board, located electronically at <http://eastportyc.org/boomerang>.

6 VENUE

The racing area will be on the Severn River and Chesapeake Bay, between the Chesapeake Bay Bridge and Cove Point.

7 COURSES

Competitors will sail one (1) fixed mark course that will start and finish in Annapolis and will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 8.1 RRS Appendix V1, Penalty at the Time of An Incident, will apply.
- 8.2 RRS Appendix V2, Penalty Taken After A Race, will apply.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 RRS A4, the Low Point scoring system will apply.
- 9.2 PHRF handicap scoring will be in accordance with the PHRF Time-on-Time Circular Random rating.
- 9.3 ORR_{EZ} handicap scoring will be wind-indexed and in accordance with CRCA class rules.

10 RADIO COMMUNICATION

[NP] Competitors shall have and monitor a working VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on VHF channels 9, 13, 16, and 73.

11 PRIZES

- 11.1 Prizes in each class will be as follows: 1st Place for three (3) or more entries;
- 11.2 The Boomerang Trophy shall be presented to the boat that finishes first in the class with the closest elapsed corrected times between 1st and 5th places. Boats competing in one-design classes will be evaluated on their elapsed times.
- 11.3 The F. Peter Weber Trophy shall be awarded to the first boat to cross the finish line, regardless of class or course, provided she is not scored OCS, retires after finishing, or is disqualified by the Protest Committee.
- 11.4 Prizes in the Patriot Cup will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Places. Results will be a calculation of finish position within the class the boat sails, ranked from highest to lowest.
- 11.5 Additional awards may be presented at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the EYC Boomerang Race entirely at their own risk; see RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will accept no liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

13 INSURANCE

[NP] Each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.

Available space will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Competitors should not assume space will be available at EYC if they do not first coordinate with the Waterfront Director.
