

GRAND TRAVERSE YACHT CLUB 2020 WEDNESDAY NIGHT SERIES AMENDMENT #1 TO MELGES 24 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Originally published as:

11. FINISH

- 11.1 The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag or shape on the RC Boat and the course side of the nearby mark of the course. The position of the RC Boat will depend on water depth around the finish mark (i.e., the line may be reversed).
- 11.2 The RC will remain on station at the finish until the time limit unless conditions dictate otherwise. If the RC is not on station, competitors shall take their own time when their bow crosses a line through the finish mark that is perpendicular to the last leg of the race and they are within 50 yds of the mark.

Change to:

11. FINISH

- 11.1 The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag or shape on the RC Boat and the course side of the nearby mark of the course. The position of the RC Boat will depend on water depth around the finish mark (i.e., the line may be reversed).
- 11.1.1 In the case of an upwind finish, a yellow inflatable cylinder may be set to starboard of the signal boat. The finish will be between the blue shape on the signal boat and the yellow cylinder
- 11.2 The RC will remain on station at the finish until the time limit unless conditions dictate otherwise. If the RC is not on station, competitors shall take their own time when their bow crosses a line through the finish mark that is perpendicular to the last leg of the race and they are within 50 yds of the mark.

15. SCORING

- 15.1 The Low Point scoring system RRS Appendix A9, "Race Scores in a Series Longer than a Regatta", will apply.
- 15.2 One race constitutes a series, applicable to the July, August, and September series. After the completion of a fourth race in a series, a throwout will be calculated removing a yacht's high score within the series.

15.3 The GTYC Wednesday Night Season Championship Series will be scored from the total of the low point totals scored in the individual series with the subtraction of an additional single race score.

Change to:

15. SCORING

- 15.1 The Low Point scoring system, RRS Appendix A and RRS Appendix A9, "Race Scores In A Series Longer Than A Regatta", will apply.
- 15.2 One race constitutes a series, applicable to the July, August, & September monthly series. After the completion of a sixth race in a series, a throw out will be calculated removing a yacht's high score. Additional throwouts will be calculated in following multiples of six.
- 15.3 The Wednesday Night Season Championship will be determined by a low point calculation of the point totals accumulated in the July, August, & September monthly series, *minus the subtraction of a yacht's highest race score not already taken as a throwout.*
