NOTICE OF RACE

**ELIGIBILITY:**

The Round Island Regatta is open to yachts with a valid PHRF certificate on file, yachts in the International One Design, J70, Watch Hill 15, Ensign classes and by invitation. Yachts without a PHRF certificate will be assigned a handicap by the Race Committee based on PHRF-Eastern Connecticut.

**RULES:**

Races will be governed by the Current Racing Rules of Sailing, prescriptions of US SAILING and the rules of the International One-Design, J-70, Ensign and Watch Hill classes (in those classes); except as any of these are modified by the sailing instructions. Sailing Instructions will be available on-line on Yacht Scoring no later than Friday, September 4 at 12 noon. PHRF classes will be handicapped by the time-on-time method.

**COURSE AND CLASSES:**

All classes will start and finish just outside West Harbor, Fishers Island. The race will be around Fishers Island, about 15 miles. Course descriptions will be in the Race Instructions. The Scratch Sheet will be posted on Yacht Scoring by noon on Friday, September 4, 2020.

**AWARDS:**

Commodore David F. Harris Trophy for 1st FIYC boat entered in a PHRF class, First, Second and Third place trophies in every class, Island Cup Trophy for combined FIYC, Mason's Island YC and Ram Island YC races, Wilkinson Trophy for fastest Corrected Time using PHRF for all boats. Trophy winners will be contacted by FIYC to determine best method of distribution.
