NOTICE OF RACE

with Amendments No. 1 and 2

1 RULES

- 1.1 Racing will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 **[DP] [NP]** One-design class rules will apply.
- 1.3 The notation "**[NP]**" in a rule in this Notice of Race means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).
- 1.4 **[DP] [NP]** Eastport Yacht Club (EYC) recommends that each competitor review and prepare their boat to the U.S. Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements, Nearshore. A copy of the Nearshore requirements is available at <http://eastportyc.org/racing>, located under "Racing Resources."

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The Fall Brawl will be the J/70 Mid-Atlantic Championship and is open to all J/70 boats sailing in compliance with the International J/70 Class Rules.
- 2.2 The J/80 and Viper 640 classes will sail the Fall Brawl in compliance with their respective class rules.

3 FEES

- 3.1 The J/70 entry fee for two (2) days of racing is:
 - ♦ \$100 for paid entries received by 2000 hours on Friday, 23 October 2020.
 - ♦ \$125 for paid entries received after 2000 hours on Friday, 23 October 2020, but before 1900 hours on Thursday, 29 October 2020.
- 3.2 The J/80 entry fee for one (1) day of racing is:
 - ♦ \$50 for paid entries received by 2000 hours on Friday, 23 October 2020.
 - ♦ \$75 for paid entries received after 2000 hours on Friday, 23 October 2020, but before 1900 hours on Thursday, 29 October 2020.
- 3.3 The Viper 640 entry fee for two (2) days of racing is:
 - ♦ \$100 for paid entries received by 2000 hours on Friday, 23 October 2020.
 - ♦ \$125 for paid entries received after 2000 hours on Friday, 23 October 2020, but before 1900 hours on Thursday, 29 October 2020.
- 3.4 A 50% entry fee refund will be provided if a request to withdraw from the regatta is received by 2000 hours on Friday, 23 October 2020.

- 4.2 For the J/70 class, a maximum of eight (8) races are scheduled, of which two (2) shall be completed to constitute a series.
- 4.3 For the J/80 class, a maximum of four (4) races are scheduled, of which one (1) shall be completed to constitute a series.
- 4.4 For the Viper 640 class, a maximum of eight (8) races are scheduled, of which two (2) shall be completed to constitute a series.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the EYC website no later than 2000 hours on Friday, 16 October 2020, and posted on the Official Notice Board, located electronically at <http://eastportyc.org/fall-brawl>.

7 VENUE

The racing area will be on the Chesapeake Bay in the vicinity of buoy R2, latitude 38° 56.51', longitude 076° 25.50.

8 COURSES

Competitors will sail drop mark courses as shown in the Sailing Instructions.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 9.1 RRS Appendix V1, Penalty at the Time of An Incident, will apply.
- 9.2 RRS Appendix V2, Penalty Taken After A Race, will apply.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 RRS Appendix A4, the Low Point System, will apply.
- 10.2 For the J/70 class, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores if five (5) or fewer races are completed. One (1) race score will be excluded if six (6) or more races are completed.
- 10.3 For the J/80 class, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 10.4 For the Viper 640 class, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores if five (5) or fewer races are completed. One (1) race score will be excluded if six (6) or more races are completed.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

[DP] [NP] Competitors shall have and monitor a working VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on VHF channels 9, 13, 16, and 73.

12 PRIZES

- 12.1 For the J/70 class overall awards will be presented at EYC on Sunday, 01 November 2020, after the conclusion of racing, social distancing will be observed.
- 1st Place for three (3) or more entries;
 - 2nd Place for six (6) or more entries;
 - 3rd Place for seven (7) or more entries.; and,
 - 4th Place for fifteen (15) or more entries.
- 12.2 The J/70 Fall Brawl Perpetual Award will be presented to the winning skipper in the J/70 class.
- 12.3 For the J/80 class overall awards will be presented at EYC on Saturday, 31 October 2020, after the conclusion of racing, social distancing will be observed.
- 1st Place for three (3) or more entries;
 - 2nd Place for six (6) or more entries;
 - 3rd Place for seven (7) or more entries; and,
 - 4th Place for fifteen (15) or more entries.

- 12.4 For the Viper 640 class, overall awards will be presented at EYC on Sunday, 1 November 2020, after the conclusion of racing, social distancing will be observed.
- 1st Place for three (3) or more entries;
 - 2nd Place for six (6) or more entries;
 - 3rd Place for seven (7) or more entries; and,
 - 4th Place for fifteen (15) or more entries.
- 12.5 Additional awards for may be presented at the discretion of the Organizing Authority (OA).

13 PROTESTS

Protests will be heard virtually via Zoom. Participants should be prepared to join a Zoom meeting with audio and visual capability following racing each day.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the Fall Brawl entirely at their own risk; see RRS 4, Decision to Race. The OA will accept no liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

15 INSURANCE

[DP] [NP] Each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.
