Notice of Race

Cape to Cape Challenge XII Saturday, August 8, 2020

The Corinthian Yacht Club of Cape May (CYCCM) together with Lewes Yacht Club (LYC) is proud to invite all offshore sailors to compete in the annual Lewes to Cape May Race for the annual "Cape to Cape" Challenge Cup. The organizing authorities are CYCCM and LYC.

- 1. **Rules**. The race will be governed by the current rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, prescriptions of US Sailing and PHRF-MA, and the Sailing Instructions. If a PHRF Certificate is not provided, the appropriate PHRF-MA rating will be assigned by the Race Committee. An entry must select the proper Spinnaker (includes J boats) or Non-Spinnaker class.
- 2. **Notice to Competitors.** Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at the Corinthian Yacht Club and Lewes Yacht Club.
- 3. **Sailing Instructions.** Sailing Instructions will be provided to all competitors at the Skipper's meetings and posted to yachtscoring.com. Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted as soon as practical. In case of a conflict between this NOR and the SI the SI will prevail.

4. Schedule of Race.

One distance race on Saturday August 8, 2020 from Lewes to Cape May.

Two classes Spinnaker first then Non-Spinnaker

PHRF- Spinnaker (Includes J boats)

PHRF- Non-Spinnaker

First Signal: 1100 hours

Boats must have a VHF radio for CH 78.

- 5. **Racing Area.** Refer to the course maps in the Sailing Instructions for courses. The racing area will be the Delaware Bay and Atlantic Ocean. The course will be announced on VHF channel 78 before 10AM Saturday. The start will be about ½ mile north of the Roosevelt Inlet and proceed on the announced course to the finish near Cape May.
- 6. **The Start.** There will be a separate start for each class: spinnaker (J's included) then non-spinnaker.
- 7. **Scoring**. The Low Point Scoring Systems, RRS A4 shall apply.
- 8. **Prizes**. Regatta prizes will be awarded as follows:

Cape Cup will be awarded to the winner of each class: Spinnaker (J boats included) and Non-

Spinnaker.
