**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1. RULES**

- 1.1. The race will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. Boats shall comply with the rules and requirements of their respective class and/or measurement rules except as changed herein.
- 1.3. The series is open to boats with a current YRA of LIS PHRF Certificate.
- 1.4. Boats without a current YRA of LIS PHRF Certificate filed with the race committee may participate but shall be scored DNC by the race committee without a hearing. This changes rules 63.1, A4.1, A5 & A9.

**2. DIVISIONS**

Divisions shall be outlined in the Sailing Instructions.

**3. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY & FEES**

- 3.1. The regatta is open to boats owned by or under charter to members of IHYC, BYC, GBYC, OGYC, RYC and Catboats from Western LIS.
- 3.2. Each boat's entry and fee of \$25 must be submitted online prior to July 25, 2020. Entries shall be made online at [www.yachtscoring.com](http://www.yachtscoring.com).

**4. SCHEDULE**

- 4.1. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first division to start will be 1455. Remaining divisions will follow as signaled.
- 4.2. One race is scheduled for each division.
- 4.3. Races not completed on July 25, 2020 will not be re-sailed.

**5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS & SCRATCH SHEETS**

The Sailing Instructions and scratch sheets will be available beginning on or before July 27 online at [www.yachtscoring.com](http://www.yachtscoring.com) and [www.indianharboryc.com](http://www.indianharboryc.com)

**6. VENUE & COURSES**

- 6.1. The starting line will be set approximately 1/8 n.m. SE of the IHYC Mooring field, located inside Captain Harbor, Greenwich, CT.
- 6.2. Courses and distances will be pre-determined and described in detail in the Sailing Instructions.
- 6.3. The finish will be the same as the start line.

7. **SCORING**

PHRF boat divisions will be scored using the time-on-time method, and the distance racing handicap issued to the boat by the YRA of LIS. The Catboat division will be scored as a one-design fleet.

8. **POST-RACE GET-TOGETHER**

IHYC-members and their guests are welcome to make reservations for dinner or drinks at a table following racing. Unfortunately the Club is not able to accommodate reciprocal or non-members at this time.

9. **PRIZES**

First, second, and third place prizes will be awarded in each division following the race. Prizes will be held at the Front Desk if competitors are not able to pick up after racing.

10. **RESPONSIBILITIES OF COMPETITORS**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the regatta.

11. **MOORINGS**

With a prior reservation, complimentary moorings will be made available for Saturday night, July 25, 2020. A regatta rate of \$25/night will be extended to boats for Friday, July 24 and/or Sunday July 26, after which standard rates apply. Discount will be applied after the reservation is confirmed.
