

Ida Lewis Yacht Club Club Championship Regatta August 30, 2020

NOTICE OF RACE Including Amendment #1

The Flag Officers of the Ida Lewis Yacht Club invite you to participate in the ILYC Club Championship Regatta which will be held on Sunday, August 30, 2020.

The event is open to all members and subscribers in good standing of the Ida Lewis Yacht Club.

Race headquarters will be located at the Ida Lewis Yacht Club, Wellington Avenue, Newport, RI.

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 will apply except as altered by this Notice of Race, by the Sailing Instructions, and any subsequent amendment.
- 1.2. The current PHRF Regulations of PHRF Narragansett Bay.
- 1.3. Advertising
 - a) Advertising shall be in accordance with World Sailing regulation 20.2.1.
 - b) Competitors may be required to display sponsor flags or graphics on the side of their hulls; these graphics, if any, will be supplied by the OA.
 - c) Advertising for tobacco products is not permitted.
 - d) Advertising that is a conflict with any race sponsor is prohibited unless permission is requested and authorized by the OA in writing.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

The ILYC Club Championship Regatta is open to the following:

2.1. Boats

- a) ILYC Member owned or chartered PHRF handicapped monohull boats with a minimum LOA of 22 feet.
- b) ILYC Member owned or chartered monohull boats without a PHRF handicap that who are assigned an event handicap by the Regatta Committee. The Regatta Committee will determine and then assign an event handicap equal to that of a comparable boat by referring:
 - 1. first to the NB PHRF register; then
 - 2. to the national PHRF register; and then
 - 3. If Committee cannot identify a directly comparable boat from either register, it may assign the event handicap based on the most comparable option.

The assignment of an event handicap by the Regatta Committee is not subject to a request for redress. This modifies RRS 62.1.

2.2. Crews

- a) The "person in charge", all helmspersons, and 1/3 of the total crew (but in no case less than two persons per boat) must be members or subscribers of ILYC, or their immediate family.
- b) All non ILYC member crew members must qualify for World Sailing category 1 standing.

3. ENTRIES:

The Entry Form is available and should be completed online via links from the Ida Lewis YC web site, www.ILYC.org. For last minute entries, entry forms will be available at the Ida Lewis Registration prior to the Skippers' Meeting.

3.1. Boats requesting assignment of an event handicap must submit their request no later than August 21, 2020.

- 3.2. A valid PHRF NB Certificate or a special event rating application must be on file with the Ida Lewis Yacht Club Race Committee by 0830 on the August 21, 2020.
- 3.3. A Participant Waiver Form will be available online. It is the responsibility of the "person in charge" to ensure that each crew member reads and signs the waiver. Participant Waiver signed by all crew members must be delivered to the Registration Desk by 0930 hours, August 21, 2020 or the entry may not be scored as a starter.
- 3.4. The entry fee for Entries submitted prior to August 26, 2020 is \$35. Entries received after August 26th will be subject to a \$15 late entry fee, for a total of \$50 (the late entry option is not available to boats requesting an assigned event handicap).
- 3.5. All eligible boats shall Check-in, in person at Ida Lewis Yacht Club on August 30, 2020 from 0800–0930 hours.

4. CLASSES:

The Entry Form is available and should be completed online via links from the Ida Lewis YC web site, www.ILYC.org. For last minute entries, entry forms will be available at the Ida Lewis Registration prior to the Skippers' Meeting.

- 4.1. There shall be a single class: PHRF Spinnaker for the Club Championship
- 4.2. PHRF Boats will be scored based on ratings assigned by PHRF Narragansett Bay or event ratings assigned by the Regatta Committee Using the Time on Time formula.

5. SAFETY:

By completing the entry process, the owner and master of each boat to declare that she is seaworthy in hull, rig, and gear and that she is properly equipped and competently manned and sailed.

6. COURSES:

6.1. The Club Championship courses will be Navigator courses using the marks listed on the most current South Bay Race Chart. The Race Committee plans to run one or two races, depending on the weather and composition of the classes.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

A representative from each boat shall report to the Administration desk located at the Ida Lewis Yacht Club between the hours of 0800 and 0900 on Sunday, August 30, 2020, to register their vessel and receive the sailing instructions.

7.1. Sailing Instructions will also be available on the Ida Lewis Yacht Club website (www.ilyc.org).
