

LAUDERDALE - KEY WEST RACE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS



Amendment 2

The U.S. Navy is conducting submarine testing in our designated starting area, which has been moved south with the following amendment. Related, the time for the first warning signal has been delayed one hour to give boats in Fort Lauderdale and Palm Beach additional time to make the start:

- 4.1 The Starting Line shall be approximately ~~one half mile~~ **five miles** south of the Port Everglades harbor entrance and approximately one mile offshore, between an inflatable race mark and a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee Signal boat.
- 4.3 The first Warning signal is scheduled to be made at ~~1000~~ **1100** hours on Thursday, January 21.

An autonomous mark may be used as the pin end of the line and the following is added for clarification.

- 4.5 Routine movement of an autonomous mark that may be used for the starting pin will not be grounds for redress, including if returning to station after having been pushed away by a competitor. Rule 31 still applies.
