Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2021-2024*, except as modified by the regatta Sailing Instructions. Updates /revisions will be posted on this website. In addition, the Ultimate 20 North Americans will be governed by the North American Championship Addendum. The Viper Class Rule requiring class bow numbers will also be in effect.

Entry Due: Friday, May 21, 2021 - *Late Fee applies after May 21st*
Early Bird Entry discount deadline - April 30th
(Early Bird Entries also receive 10 free regatta drink tickets)

Entry Fee: PHRF & ONE DESIGN FLEETS (Fri/Sat/Sun):
Early Bird = \$155. Entries after April 30th= \$170.
CRUISING & MULTIHULL FLEETS (Sat/Sun only):
Early Bird = \$ 84. Entries after April 30th= \$ 99.

OLD POINT BANK LOYALTY DISCOUNT:

All 2019 SBRW returnees deduct \$25 from each above fee.

LATE FEE: Additional \$25 for entries received after May 21st

NOTE: In the unlikely event that COVID-19 issues cause the cancellation of the regatta, all entry fees will be refunded. With this in mind, racers are encouraged to enter early so as to give event organizers time to plan the customary SBRW and HYC trademark southern hospitality.

Eligibility: All boats must be at least 20 feet LOA. Classes expected include **PHRF A, B, C, NS** (double headsail allowed), **One-Design classes to include: Viper 640, Ultimate 20, J70, J24, S2 7.9 and others with 4 or more entries. Also expected are Cruising and Multihull fleets.**

PHRF, Cruising and Multihull fleet boats must meet the Nearshore category of the US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements (which are posted at the HYC website). Boats may not be sailed single-handed. All PHRF fleet competitors must have a current, valid PHRF of the Chesapeake rating certificate. Multihull boats must have a current, valid Chesapeake Multihull Association rating.

One Design classes and Multihull Division boats must have at least four (4) entered and paid by May 15th.

SBRW 2021 RACING PROGRAM

PHRF DIVISION

- Friday & Sunday - in the Harbor
 - Multiple windward-leeward courses with long/short weather marks and gates
 - Experienced RC and mark boats to keep things square and moving
 - 6 - 8 race series intended
- Saturday - SBRW Distance Race in the Bay
 - Unique courses of 12-23 miles with multiple options to shorten if the wind goes light
 - Start off Buckroe; finish line is off historic Fort Monroe seawall
 - **NEW in 2021** - **If weather prevents racing in the Bay**, all fleets will race in the Harbor:
 - + PHRF & One Design will sail windward-leeward (separate courses and RC)
 - + Cruisers and Multihulls will sail a random leg race (separate course and RC)

ONE-DESIGN DIVISION

- All three days - multiple windward-leeward racing in the Harbor
- Short courses with offset marks and gates
- 9 - 12 race series intended
- ULTIMATE 20 class - *2021 ULTIMATE 20 NORTH AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP*

CRUISING & MULTIHULL DIVISION

- Two days of racing...four days of fun...for a reduced entry fee
- Saturday - SBRW Distance Race in the Bay (different course lengths for different fleets)
- Sunday - One Random Leg race (separate course and RC)
- **NEW in 2021 - CONDO CRUISERS FLEET**
 - Limited to boats 40' and up
 - Kinder, gentler approach, but still racing
 - A separate fleet in the Cruising Division with appropriate course distances
- Multihulls - Chesapeake Multihull Association ratings
