### **AMENDMENT # 2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **SI 11 THE START is changed as follows:**

11.2 the race committee will attempt to hail her sail or bow number.

#### **SI 13 THE FINISH is changed as follows:**

13.2 Code flag AP over A will be displayed at the finish to indicate no more racing today.

#### **SI 16 is deleted and replaced with:**

#### **16 HEARING REQUESTS**

- 16.1. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered online on Yachtscoring regatta webpage by logging into the owner's corner and filling out the online form. If this is unavailable, then by filling out a protest form (a fillable form is available under general race forms on YS regatta webpage) and emailing it, or a picture (or pictures) of the form to: [protest@coralreefyachtclub.org](mailto:protest@coralreefyachtclub.org). This changes RRS 61.3 and 62.2.
- 16.2. The protest time limit shall be one (1) hour after the docking time of the RC finish vessel and the time limit will be posted on the ONB.
- 16.3. Notices will be posted on the ONB no later than 15 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties. The protest desk will be located on the 2nd floor SE end of the Boathouse. Parties and their witnesses should report there at the scheduled hearing time. Non-CRYC members may only come to CRYC for this purpose, or as otherwise provided in the COVID Regatta Rules.
- 16.4. RRS 62.2 is changed. The time limit stated is changed from two hours to one hour.
- 16.5. Within the protest time limit, the RC shall post the bow numbers or sail numbers of all of the boats that are disqualified or penalized under RRS 29, RRS 30, SI 19.2.
- 16.6. After a hearing, penalties for violations of rules other than those of Part 2 will be at the discretion of the protest committee and may include disqualification.
