

- 3.1 This amendment replaces Amendment No. 3 issued on 9th June 2021.
- 3.2 The Royal Southern YC Solent Area Mark Codes 2021 as described in Appendix 1 is deleted and replaced with Version 3 as published on 18th May 2021.

Changes are as follows:

1. The new **mark 48 Paul Heys** has now been laid, after a delay, but its position has changed after requests from Red Funnel and the Southampton pilots for it to be placed 300m to the SE so that it was further from the Calshot N cardinal buoy and the Thorn channel. The position of 48 Paul Heys is now 50 48.21N, 01 16.68W.
 2. There was a 'typo' in the lists issued in February for **mark 78 Hook**. The position should read 50 49.52N, 01 18.30W.
 3. **Mark 4S Royal Southern** was about 150m out of position but has now been moved to the correct spot as listed at 50 48.86N, 01 15.43W.
 4. **Mark 7N Royal Southampton** has been removed.
 5. Amended marks lists are attached, in Excel and PDF formats, including the changes.
- 3.3 For Black Group, the table in SI 6.1 is amended to the following, including the rating bands applicable for the 3 IRC classes.
