Rendezvous: At 1030 in vicinity of Region 1 Mark Q (G"1MR"),

be alert for code flag "L".

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 72 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Start: The anticipated time of the first warning is at 1100.

Between blue flag on Race Committee boat and a Region 1 mark <u>OR</u> a temporary mark set by Race Committee. If a temporary mark is set, it automatically becomes Mark "Y" and may be used as a course mark. All boats must start within 15 minutes of their starting time. For PHRF classes, the second and third races will start as soon as

practical after the last boat in class has finished the prior race.

Signals: RRS 26 (Starting Races) as changed by: Starts will be offered for the following classes.

Course: For PHRF classes, it is anticipated to conduct a total of five (5) races, with three (3)

races on Saturday and two (2) races on Sunday. These will be Windward/Leeward (W/L) courses of approximately 4NM. Each race will be a CBYRA sanctioned event.

For CRCA classes we plan to provide one distance race on Saturday. For Multihulls we are planning a distance race on Saturday and 2 windward/leeward races on

Sunday.

Finish: For PHRF classes, finish between the blue flag on the Race Committee boat and

finishing mark.

For CRCA classes and multihulls, a separate course will be established and boats will finish between the blue flag on the Race Committee boat and the finishing mark.

All courses may be shortened at any designated course mark.

Rules: This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing

(RRS) 2021-2024. Rule 44.1 (Taking a Penalty) is modified to allow a boat to take a one turn penalty when she has broken one or more rules of Part 2. The CBYRA Green Book

General Sailing Instructions will apply.

The "US SER Nearshore Category" of the US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements

(available on the US Sailing website, www.USSailing.org) will apply.

Protests: Verbally notify Race Committee boat of protest prior to leaving finish area. Mail protest

forms, postmarked by Tuesday June 29, 2021 with copies sent to protestee and David Kozera, 1408 Bare Hills Road, Baltimore, MD. 21209. Parties involved in protests will be

notified of date, place, and time of hearing.

Scoring: The RRS Appendix A4 (Low Point Scoring System) will apply. For PHRF classes, two

races constitute a series.

Awards: Trophies will be presented for each race (1st/3, 2nd/5 & 3rd/7+ finishers). For the Northern

Bay PHRF Championship perpetual trophies for each class winner will be presented by

the CBYRA and PHRF.

Social: On Saturday, after racing, we'll host a party at Markley's Marina with a sumptuous

home cooked barbeque dinner. We'll observe social distancing and practice the safety standards of the day while we enjoy each other's company and recognizing the day's winners. There will be a live band playing into the night and **plenty of beer**, a return

somewhat to normal times.
