3. Official Notice Board and Announcements:

Official notices will be posted on the Official Notices section of the SMYC Website. Changes to the scoring instructions, courses, and start orders will be announced by VHF

4. Location of starts

The starts will be in Simpson Bay between a staff displaying an orange flag on the committee boat and the starting mark. This may be changed by notifying entered competitors by email the day before any racing day.

5. Location of finish

Racing Class Race 1: Finish will be in Simpson Bay between a staff displaying an orange flag on the committee boat and the starting mark.

All other classes and Racing Class Race 2: Finish will be in Friar’s Bay between a 40ft Sailing Vessel with a large blue flag stamped “volvo penta” and a big yellow buoy.

This may be changed by notifying entered competitors by VHF on the racing day.

6. Courses

Courses to be sailed will be announced by VHF prior to the first warning signal of each start sequence.

7. Scoring

7.1 Scoring will be by the low point system.

7.2 An entrant not competing in any of the races will be scored with number of registered entries plus one.

8. prizes

8.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first three boats in each class at 2pm at Friar’s Bay Sailing Club.
