



**NOTICE OF RACE
2021 SYC Fall Regatta
Sarnia Yacht Club
Sarnia, Ontario
October 16-17**

1.0 RULES

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the CYA, the International Shark Class Association (ISCA) General Class Rules and Specifications, and this Notice of Race, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES

2.1 The regatta is open to Shark class sailboats

2.2 In addition to the requirements of RRS 75.1, a boat must be registered by a member in good standing of a Shark Class National Association, and that person must be the person in charge (RRS 46).

2.3 RRS 78.1 is modified so that a boat which does not comply with class rules concerning measurement or does not have a valid measurement certificate may compete, and will not be subject to protest under the rule, if:

- a) it complies with all other class rules
- b) it has not competed in another CSCA sanctioned counter regatta that year
- c) it has not been issued a valid measurement certificate within the past five years
- d) the person in charge has signed the statement of understanding on the entry form.

4.0 LAUNCHING & MOORING

Launch / haul out is on the SYC property.

The dry-sail crane is available at the following times **Friday, October 15 AFTER 1:00 PM** and **Saturday BEFORE 8:00 AM** due to previously scheduled yacht club haul-out dates. There aren't any restrictions on the hoist for Sunday haul-out.

All boats will be assigned a well at launch. Empty trailers should be moved to the North shore as soon as possible.

Local boats are requested to launch Thursday and haul out after all out of town boats are on their trailers.

5.0 REGISTRATION

Registration fee is \$65.00 (includes three meal tickets for Saturday night)

Additional dinners are \$10 each

5.2 Yachtscoring entry must list skipper and crew to comply with SYC contact tracing policies.

6.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Sailing Instructions will be posted on Yacht Scoring and be made available registration.

7.0 SCORING

7.1 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

7.2 A minimum of 1 race is required to constitute a regatta.

8.0 CREW SUBSTITUTIONS

Substitution of crew during the regatta must be approved in writing by the regatta or protest committee chairperson.

9.0 PRIZES & TROPHIES

Keeper prizes will be awarded to the top 3 skippers and crews.

10.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11.0 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$2,000,000.

12.0 COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

Masks must be worn inside all buildings within the Sarnia Yacht Club property, including clubhouses and washrooms, by competitors and their guests. Please make sure any used masks or personal items are disposed of appropriately in one of the many garbage receptacles on the property. Club facilities will be cleaned each day, please do your part to maintain a safe and healthy space. Competitors and guests are expected to adhere to social distancing guidelines in place as of the date of the event.
