## KITEBOARD COURSE

(Numbering corresponds to the RRS Appendix S)

INCLUDING **Amendment 1** Posted 2022-05-20

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

### 3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

**3.1** Delete RRS Appendix S 3.1 and replace with 'Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0900 on the day it will take effect, unless this time is changed in the supplement. Any change to the **schedule** will be posted by 2000 online (<https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=15119>) on the day before it will take effect.'

### 4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

**4.1** Signals made ashore will be displayed at the kite beach, approximately 150m SE of the Woodbine Bathing Station; <https://goo.gl/maps/yUHzRLncDBHWSLiT8>

**4.2** When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in the race signal AP.

### 5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

**5.3** Number of races

Date	Scheduled Races per day	First Warning Signal
Saturday May 21	6	1100
Sunday May 22	6	1000

**5.4** On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 1500 hrs

**5.5** A maximum of 8 races may be sailed per day, with no more than 12 races overall.

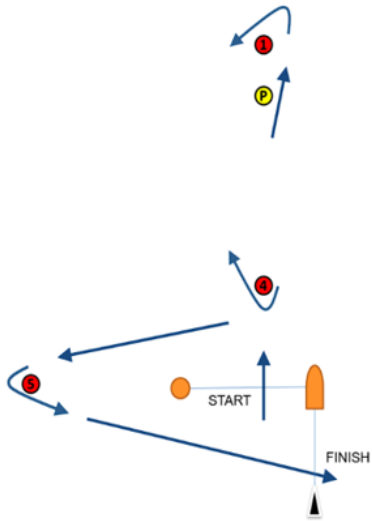

XS 1: Start – Pp – 1p – Pp – 4s – 5p – Finish

XS 2: Start – Pp – 1p – Pp – 4s – Pp – 1p – Pp – 4s – 5p – Finish

XS 3: Start – Pp – 1p – Pp – 4s – Pp – 1p – Pp – 4s – Pp – 1p – Pp – 4s – 5p – Finish

## 8. MARKS

Mark	Description
1, 4, 5	Yellow inflatable
P	Pink inflatable
Start	Boat displaying an orange flag Green inflatable
Finish	Boat displaying a blue flag Red inflatable

## 9. THE START

9.1 Races shall be started by using the following signals. Times shall be taken from the visual signals; the absence of a sound signal shall be disregarded.

Minutes before Starting Signal	Visual Signal	Sound Signal	Means
3	Class Flag up	one	Warning
2	Preparatory Flag up	one	Preparatory
1	Preparatory Flag down	one long	One Minute
0	Class Flag down	one	Start

9.3 A kiteboarder that does not start within 1 minute after their starting signal will be scored Did Not Start (DNS) without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and A5.2.
