NOTICE OF RACE

The organizing authority is the Lakeside Yacht Club

The denotation “[DP]” in a rule in the NOR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule, may be at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification. The denotation “[NP]” in a rule in the NOR means Non Protested by the competitors but may be protested by the RC and/or Protest Committee. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) for 2021-2024.
- 1.2 The CYRA Rules, the SSPHRF Rules and any Class Rules that will be defined by the OA.[DP]
- 1.3 All boats are required to have a working VHF. [DP] [NP]
- 1.4 US Sailing Prescriptions to rules 60.3(b), 67, 76.1, 88.2, Rule 61.4, Appendix V1 will apply. Appendix V1 is listed in Addendum A.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising shall only be displayed in accordance with Regulation 20 - World Sailing Advertising Code.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the OA. [DP] [NP]

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats entered by an owner who is a member in goodstanding of any yacht club as of the date of entry. Owners should be current members of their national governing body. [DP] [NP]
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter online at yachtscoring.com

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available at registration and will be posted online on or before July 22, 2022.

7. VENUE AND COURSES

- 7.1 Racing will take place on the waters of Lake Erie within 30 minutes of LYC.
- 7.2 Weather permitting, a distance race may be included.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 One completed race will constitute a regatta.

9. COMMUNICATIONS

- 9.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones and other electronic devices. [DP]
- 9.2 The race committee intends to use VHF marine radio frequencies to broadcast courtesy information, including OCS hails after starts, to competitors. Failure of a boat to hear a broadcast by the race committee will not be grounds for redress. This adds to RRS 62.1(a).

10. PRIZES

- 10.1 The winner of The Ruhlman Trophy will receive The Jon R Ruhlman Perpetual Trophy. Keeper trophies will be presented to the top three boats in their respective classes.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of US \$500,000 per incident or the equivalent.

13. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in the regattas, a competitor automatically grants the Organizing Authority, the class and the sponsors, in perpetuity, make use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any (still) motion pictures, live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the competitor and its material, during and after the event without compensation.

ADDENDUM A

Appendix V1

PENALTY AT THE TIME OF AN INCIDENT

The first two sentences of rule 44.1 are changed to: 'A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 or rule 31 in an incident while *racing*. However, when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 while in the *zone* around a *mark* other than a starting *mark*, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty.'
