Cruising Class Weekend Series Amendments to 2022 *Cedar Point Yacht Club Notice of Race and 2022 Cedar Point Yacht Club Sailing Instructions for the Fixed Mark Race Area.*

Amendment #1 to Notice of Race 4.3 and 5.1: The entry fee for Cedar Point Cruising Class Weekend Series is \$12.00. The entry procedure for that series can be found at **yachtscoring.com.**,

Amendment #1 to Sailing Instructions: Divisions: In the Sunday Series, the Navigator's Series, and the Aunt Kate/Uncle Dan Series, boats shall race in the following divisions and fly the appropriate code flag from their backstay:

Division 1 – Spinnaker boats fully crewed

Division 2—Spinnaker boats racing single-, double-, or triple-handed

Division 3 – Non-spinnaker boats, for which the use of flying sails is prohibited

In the Jackie Flournoy Cup, all boats shall race non-spinnaker, with the use of flying sails prohibited. Division assignments shall be made by the Race Committee and communicated to the fleet prior to the harbor start.

Amendment #2 to Sailing Instructions: Scoring: In Cruising Class Weekend Series races, the YRA of LIS Adjusted W/L Non-Spinnaker PHRF rating shall be used to score boats in Division III and in the Jackie Flournoy Cup, and the YRA of LIS Adjusted W/L Spinnaker PHRF rating shall be used to score boats in Division I (Fully-Crewed) and II (Single-, Double-, or Triple-Handed).

Each race and series shall be scored using the Low Point System of Appendix A of The Racing Rules of Sailing, modified so that boats which did not start correctly (OCS), did not sail the course (NSC), did not finish (DNF), retired (RET), or were disqualified (DSQ) shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats that started in that race. Time limits, and the scoring for boats that are still racing when the time limit expires (TLE), are set forth in Instruction 16 of the *Cedar Point Yacht Club Sailing Instructions for the Fixed Mark Race Area*. Boats which did not compete (DNC) or did not start (DNS) in any race shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats in the series and shall not be included as a boat starting. Each boat's series score shall be the total of her best race scores in the number of races needed to qualify for that series, excluding its other scores. This changes RRS A2 and A5.2.

Corrected times shall be calculated for each race using Time on Time ("ToT") scoring. Time Correction Factors ("TCF") used for ToT scoring shall be calculated by the formula TCF=A/(B+PHRF rating) using A=650 and B= 550.

Amendment #3 to Sailing Instructions: Prizes: Daily and series prizes in each division will reflect PHRF handicap results. Daily prizes for each division shall be awarded to the top three boats in each day's racing. Series prizes for each division shall be awarded based on their order of finish in their division series.
