NOTICE OF RACE

The notation [NP] in a rule in the NOR means it shall not be grounds for protest by a boat This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. RULES

- 1.1. All Participants are expected to comply with Covid-19 Health Orders from the State of California and the County of San Francisco; and the StFYC Site Specific Plan for Covid-19. Proof of vaccination is required to enter the STFYC Clubhouse. (NP)
- 1.2. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, Appendix V, and the local fleet rules for each of the One-Design classes.
- 1.3. Rule 40.1 will apply at all times when boats are in the racing area, and on their way to and from the racing area.
- 1.4. US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.1 and 63.2 are deleted.

2. HANDICAPPED CLASS BREAKS & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1. Handicapped class breaks (as required) will be posted on the StFYC Official Notice Board by 1700 Thursday, August 18.
- 2.2. The sailing instructions will be available by 1700 Thursday, August 18 online at www.stfyc.com/racing.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1. The online official notice board is located at www.stfyc.com/racing.
- 3.2. [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channels 9, 13, 16, 68, 69, 70, 71, and 72.
- 3.3. On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The specific channel will be stated in the SIs.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. The race is open to:
 - a. One design classes: Knarrs, Folkboats, Moore 24, Express 37, J/88, J/105. Other one design classes with aLOA \geq 30' are invited to contact the StFYC Race Office by August 1 for possible inclusion in the regatta.
 - b. Monohull boats with a LOA \geq 30' and a current ORC or PHRF rating certificate.
- 4.2. Classes must have a minimum of six (6) boats registered by August 9 to qualify for a start.
- 4.3. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at www.stfyc.com on or before 1700 Thursday, August 18.
- 4.4. An entry is not considered complete until the entry fee is received.

6. FEES

- 6.1. The entry fee is \$5.50 per foot LOA, rounded up to the nearest foot.

- 6.2. The entry fee is \$50 for boats racing on Friday only.
- 6.3. Entries received on or after Tuesday August 16 are subject to a \$50.00 late fee.

7. RACE AREA AND COURSE

- 7.1. Racing on 8/19 (Aldo Alessio Race)
 - a. The race committee intends to conduct a single distance race utilizing San Francisco Bay and its approaches.
- 7.2. Racing on 8/20 and 8/21 (Phyllis Kleinman Swiftsure Regatta)
 - a. Will take place on the city front north of StFYC.
 - b. The courses may be a windward - leeward or any variation of a triangular or other course.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. For all classes:
 - a. One (1) race will constitute a series.
 - b. All races on Saturday and Sunday will count towards a boat's final score. This changes RRS A2.
- 8.2. For PHRF: A boat's corrected time will be calculated using the Time on Time scoring method.
- 8.3. For ORC: A boat's corrected time will be calculated using ORC scoring options as determined by the Race Committee.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS Appendix V – Alternative Penalties will apply for all boats.

10. AWARDS

- 10.1. Prizes will be awarded based on participation.
- 10.2. The Aldo Alessio Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the first-place finisher on Friday in the PHRF Division.
- 10.3. The Phyllis Kleinman Swiftsure Cup will be awarded to the first-place boat in ORC A Division based on their final score.
- 10.4. A trophy will be awarded to the boat with the "best dressed crew (either on the water or post-race)".

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

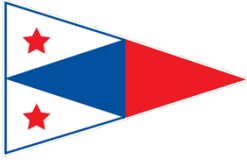

The race organizers (OA, Ratings Authority, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this regatta. By participating in this regatta, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

12. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

- 12.1. By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
- 12.2. Additionally, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and race officials the right to use their personal contact information, including but not limited to a current email address and cell phone number, for the purpose of race administration and regatta communications.
