Objective

The 2023 GL52 Summer Series is intended to encourage like-minded TP52 type boat owners, with a healthy mix of Corinthian and Pro sailor crews, to compete in similarly configured boats under the ORC on a Time-on-Time basis in a group of Great Lakes distance races and buoy races that form a Summer series.

1.0 Eligibility

- 1.1 LOA Limit Between 15.500 -15.860m.
- 1.2 TPS Limit Less than or equal 9.20m.
- 1.3 ISP Limit
 - Age Date 2008 and before less than 23.800m.
 - Age Date 2009 and beyond less than 23.150m.
- 1.4 Draft Limit
 - Age Date 2008 and before less than 3.710m.
 - Age Date 2009 and beyond less than 3.610m.
- 1.5 Displacement Limit Maximum 8500 kg in Measurement Trim.
- 1.6 ORC Offshore Certificate Handicap Limit None.
- 1.7 ORC Inshore Certificate Handicap Limit None.

2.0 Rules

- 2.1 The Series will be governed by rules as defined in current (2021-2024) The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2.2 This 2023 GL52 Notice of Summer Series.
- 2.3 2023 ORC Rule.
- 2.4 Safety Equipment Requirements per issued by each event.
- 2.5 NOR and SI per each event.

3.0 ORC Certificates

3.1 Allow (1) ORC Inshore Certificate configuration per year with data submitted to US Sailing, by June 1, 2023, for first designated GL52 Buoy Event. ORC Inshore Certificate with the exact same configuration shall be used for all other designated GL52 Buoy Events.

- 3.2 Allow (2) ORC **Offshore Certificate** configurations per year for designated GL52 Offshore Events.
- The ORC only allows (1) valid ORC Certificate at a time. Amendments to the ORC Inshore Certificate to become the Queen's Cup and, if desired to become the Bayview Offshore Certificate and, if desired, to later become the Chicago Offshore Certificate. Each Offshore Certificate configuration shall be submitted to US Sailing by June 1, 2023. Test Certificates will be run by US Sailing to precheck submitted Offshore Certificate configuration/s.
- 3.4 US Sailing will apply and un-apply amendements to the ORC Inshore Certificate to become the appropriate Offshore Certificate in collaboration with Queen's Cup Race, Bayview Mackinac Race & Race to Mackinac OA's.
- 3.5 GL52's may use ORC **Inshore Certificate** or either of the ORC **Offshore Certificate** configurations described above or a single ORC **Offshore Certificate** for designated GL52 Distance Events.

4.0 Sailing Condition

- 4.1 For designated GL52 Buoy Events, all GL52's shall:
 - a. Race in the Sailing Trim Condition reflected on the yacht's ORC Inshore Certificate per 3.1.
 - b. Race with same Crew, as declared, for each event except as allowed per 5.4.
 - c. Not use MHJO, MHG, Flying Headsail, LRH, MHAO, FRJO, FRG, FRAO for designated GL52 Buoy Event, even if rated with any of these sails.
- 4.2 For designated GL52 Distance Events, all GL52's shall race in the Sailing Trim Condition reflected on the yacht's submitted ORC Certificate per 3.2-3.3.

5.0 Support Boats

- 5.1 Support boats are allowed.
- 5.2 No Sail or Gear transfer, between yacht and support boat, on the water allowed after yacht departs dock.
- 5.3 No Crew transfer, between yacht and support boat, on the water allowed after yacht departs dock.
- 5.4 Teams may declare prior to the first day of racing, substitutes for Owner and wife of similar weight if either, or both, chose to not sail on any given day with notice given to RC and the substitution made before to yacht departs dock. Owner may get off yacht on a given day, after yacht departs dock, but not get back on yacht on that day with the further stipulation that no other person from the support boat can replace Owner on that day.

7.0 Entry Fee

Entry Fee for the 2023 GL52 Summer Series will be announced by May 1, 2023 and due by June 1, 2022, and payable on Yacht Scoring 2023 GL52 Summer Series page. https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eid=15517 Entry Fee covers:

- Series Scoring for all GL52 events as posted in 2022 GL52 Notice of Summer Series.
- MarkSetBots at all designated GL52 Buoy Race events.
- Big Red Regatta, Little Traverse Cup and Macatawa Championship entry.

See Bayview Mackinac Race, Race to Mackinac, Ugotta Regatta events for their Entry fee and registration details.

8.0 Event Scoring

All Events will be scored with ORC TOT method per below with non GL52's removed.

- GL52 Buoy Event (Handicap selection per event Organizing Authority/PRO per GL52 Scoring Protocol)
 - o W/L 50/50 5 Band (Low, Medium-Low, Medium, Medium High, High)
 - All Purpose Triple Number (Low, Medium, High)
- GL52 Distance Event
 - Queen's Cup Race (Handicap selection per event Organizing Authority)
 - Bayview Mackinac Race (Handicap selection per event Organizing Authority)
 - Race to Mackinac (Handicap selection per event Organizing Authority)

9.0 Summer Series Scoring

GL52's that meet the 1.0 Eligibility clause, and have paid Entry Fee per 7.0, will be scored in the 2023 GL52 Summer Series. Scoring will be per the following:

- 9.1 Low-Point system applied to finish Place per Appendix A.
- 9.2 Appendix A5.3, Scoring for a Series longer than a Regatta will apply.
- 9.3 **2023 GL52 Summer Overall Series Perpetual Trophy** will be awarded to the lowest overall score of the Summer Overall Series. Must sail, and score two (2) GL52 designated Distance Events.
- 9.4 **2023 GL52 Summer Inshore Sub Series Perpetual Trophy** will be awarded to the lowest score for all races of the Inshore Sub Series.
- 9.5 **2023 GL52 Summer Corinthian Sub Series Perpetual Trophy** will be awarded to the lowest overall score of the Summer Corinthian Sub Series and requirements of the Corinthian Deed of Trophy.

Notice! At the time of scheduling these races, it is our understanding that the races can be run in compliance with all lawful state-imposed restrictions. However, each team shall be responsible for taking those measures that may be necessary to be in compliance and shall release MBYC and the Race Committee from any obligations to monitor or force such restrictions.
