**2. RULES**

2.1 Racing will be governed by the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the ELIYA General Conditions except as changed by this document.

**3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

3.1 The Sag Harbor Cup is open to all sailboats with a valid 2023 PHRF-ELI Certificate. Although PHRF certificates are not needed for boats racing in One Design divisions. Division 4 (cruising class) will be assigned local PHRF ratings from the RC. **4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS - DIVISIONS**

4.1 **Blue Circle - Saturday July 15<sup>th</sup> & Sunday July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2023** - 1200 hrs. First Sound Signal in the leeward end of Noyack Bay

4.1.1 **J-109 – One Design** – Last race starts no later than 1500 hrs.

4.2 **Red Circle** Saturday, July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023 - 1200 hrs. First Sound Signal in the leeward end of Noyack Bay

4.2.1 **Div 1 & 2 (spinnaker PHRF Boats)**

4.2.2 **Div 3 (non-spinnaker PHRF Boats)**

4.2.3 **Div 4 (cruising)**

4.2.4 **J-70 – One Design** – Max 3 Crew, inclusive of skipper.

4.3 Rumrunner Challenge – All Divisions – Saturday, July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023 - Scored separately from other races. First Sound Signal 1600 hrs. starting east of North Haven and west of Majors Harbor on Shelter Island and probably finishing at the Sag Harbor breakwater.

**5. ENTRY FEES** – Due by 5 pm on Thursday, July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

5.1 **One-day event.** \$75.00 Covers boat entry, 2 tickets to post race party, and a Sag Cup hat.

All registration and payments need to be done directly through the Sag Harbor Cup Yacht Scoring Page.

5.2 **J109, Two-day event.** \$150.00 Covers boat entry, 8 tickets to post race parties, and a Sag Cup hat.

**6. THE COURSES – TWO CIRCLES**

- 6.1 (BLUE Circle) J109 Windward–Leeward races with the number of legs posted by RC. (VHF Channel 73)
- 6.2 (RED Circle) The course for each division will be selected by the Race Committee from the list of courses contained in the sailing instructions. Courses will be announced (VHF Channel 72) and posted by the RC on station prior to any start sequence. The race will start in Noyack Bay and finishing near Majors Cove.
- 6.3 First gun for all races (except the Rumrunner Challenge) will be in Noyack Bay and Finish where indicated by the RC

**7. SCORING**

- 7.1 J-109 Class will be scored using the low point system.
- 7.2 All other classes will be scored using time on time.

**8. PRIZES**

- 8.1 Trophies will be awarded for first, second, and third in all divisions, with at least 4 boats entered. Various trophy categories will be awarded, including Club Team, Junior, Female Helmswoman, and more.
- 8.2 Rumrunner Challenge Trophy = Barrel of rum. PHRF race.
- 8.3 The Founders Cup Trophy will be awarded to the boat that fundraised the most amount for our Junior Sailing Program.

**9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 9.1 Sailing Instructions will be available through the Sag Harbor Cup Yachtscoring page and will be available from the Race Committee Boat prior to the regatta. Entrants will be notified by email of any changes to the Sailing Instructions by 6 pm prior to the day of the race, otherwise will be notified by the Race Committee Boat on the day of the Race.

**10. ENTERTAINMENT**

- 10.1 A Post Race Party will be held at the Breakwater Clubhouse. Open to all participants and friends.
- 10.2 Saturday 1700 hrs. Food and Beverages will be served. Tickets are available on the Sag Harbor Cup Website [www.sagharborcup.org](http://www.sagharborcup.org)
- 10.3 Sunday, J-109's awards will be at the Breakwater Clubhouse following racing.
