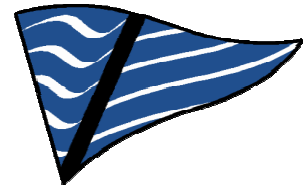

## Notice of Regatta

## 2023 May Cup

MAY 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>, 31<sup>st</sup>

### 1. RULES

1.1 The U.S. Sailing Association's Racing Rules of Sailing 2020-2024 edition will govern this regatta.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY

2.1 All competitors must:

2.1a Be members in good standing of Breakwater Yacht Club

2.1b Have paid the entry fee

2.1c Have boat insurance covering racing

2.1d Have submitted a current PHRF/ELI certificate by **Wednesday, May 24**

2.2 Visiting boats may enter at a cost of \$20.00 per individual race but will not be scored for the series.

2.3 Eligibility to race for visiting yachts is up to the discretion of the Regatta Committee.

2.4 **No competitor will be scored without fulfilling all eligibility requirements prior to the race.**

### 3. FEES

3.1 \$50 for US Sailing Members

3.2 \$55 for non-US Sailing members

3.3 All Registration needs to be done through the Breakwater Yacht Club 2023 May Cup on Yachtscoreing.

### 4. DIVISIONS

Division 1 (Spinnaker)

Division 3 (Non-Spinnaker)

Division 4 (J-70 One-Design)

The Race Committee reserves the right to classify certain boats as it sees fit.

### 5. COURSES

5.1 All races will be run in Shelter Island Sound.

5.2 Courses will be displayed from a board on the committee boat.

### 6. START

The start shall be in the area west of Majors Cove in Shelter Island Sound. The RC shall attempt to sound the first gun at 6:00 PM local time.

### 7. SCORING

7.1 For each division, the low point scoring system (U.S. Sailing rules Appendix A – using A5.2 and A5.3 modified to count DNS, NSC, DNF, RET, DSQ, and OSC as scored equal to the number of series boats coming to the starting area and keeping DNC scored as 1 more than the number of boats entered in the series) will be used.

7.2 A boat's best scores for 65% of the races run, rounded normally to a whole number, will be counted to score the series.

### 8. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in all divisions with at least 3 boats entered there.

### 9. CHANGES

Changes to the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Breakwater Yacht Club 2023 May Cup Yachtscoreing. Skippers may also be notified by email.
