7 THE COURSE

7.1 Alpha course will be located approximately one nautical mile southwest of Centennial Pier off Toronto Island. The course layout is outlined in appendix A.

7.2 Bravo Course will be located on a bearing of approximately 210 degrees magnetic, 1.6nm from the entrance to NYC. The course layout is outlined in appendix B.

8 MARKS

The colour of marks will be:

8.2 For a course change, the offset mark will not be set.

8.3 If either mark 1 or 1a is missing the single mark shall be rounded to port.

8.4 If one of gate marks (2p/2s or 3s/3p) is missing then the remaining mark will be rounded to port.

12 TIME LIMITS

12.1 The Mark 1 Time Limit, Race Time Limit and the Finishing Window are shown in the table below.

Bravo will be on VHF 74.

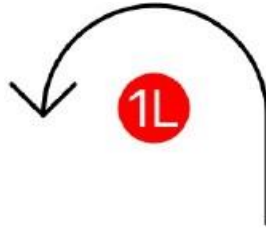
15 SCORING

15.1 One race will constitute a series.

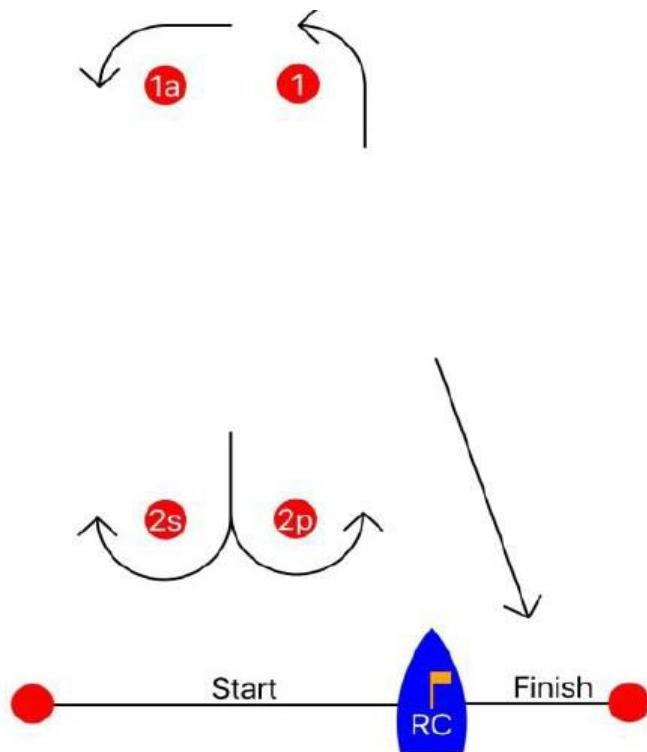
15.2 A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.

8Metre only - Mark Rounding Order: Start - 1L - 2s/2p - 1L - Finish

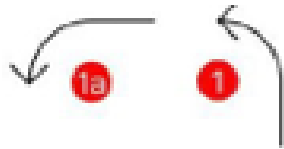


All Other Classes - Mark Rounding Order: Start - 1-1a - 2s/2p - 1-1a - Finish
