

NEW YEARS CUP 2025 SWFL BOTY EVENT

January 4-5, 2025 Notice of Race (NoR)

1. Management:

1.1 The organizing authority for the race is the GCSC. GCSC will have the authority to interpret the conditions governing the event, assign yachts to classes and reserve the right to reject the entry of any yacht in compliance with US National Prescription 76.1.

2. Rules:

- 2.1 The Regatta is governed by the rules as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), the class rules of the West Florida Performance Handicap Racing Fleet (WFPHRF), this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.2 The following prescriptions of the US national authority will apply; 65.1, 76.1, 88.2.

3. Eligibility:

3.1 The race is open to monohull and multihull sailing yachts measuring a minimum overall length of Nineteen feet (19+).

4. Registration & Fees

- 4.1 Regatta entry is available on the event entry page at www.yachtscoring.com and search "Naples" or the direct link https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=16977
- 4.2 The cost for regatta entry is \$85.00 per boat which includes both days of racing. PLEASE Register using this direct link:
 - Yacht Scoring A complete web based regatta management, administration and yacht scoring program
- 4.3 Awards Meals are \$30.00 per person, pre-pay on the event entry page under "Event Purchases" or this direct link:
 - Yacht Scoring A complete web based regatta management, administration and yacht scoring program
 - Party Guests or visitors payable as cash/check at the door
- 4.4 There will be a cash bar.

5. Classes:

5.1 Classes shall have a minimum of three entries and will be divided into classes:

Spinnaker

True Cruising

Non-Spinnaker

Multihull/MultiCruiser

6. Scoring:

- 6.1 PHRF handicaps will apply and be scored time-on-distance. Boats without a valid PHRF certificate may be allowed to participate in this event at the sole discretion of the organizing authority.
- 6.2 A valid PHRF certificate is required to be scored in the SW FL WFPHRF BOTY Series.

7. Venue:

7.1 The racing area for both days will be on the Gulf of Mexico in the vicinity of Gordon Pass and Naples Pier.

8. Courses:

- 8.1 For the PHRF Spinnaker and Multihull classes, the course shall be 2 laps, (5 legs) Olympic Triangle followed by a single windward leeward lap. (Windward, reach, reach, windward, leeward to the finish.)
- 8.2 For the non-Spinnaker and True Cruising classes, the course shall be a 1 lap (3 legs) Olympic Triangle (Windward, Reach, then Reach to the Finish)

10. Sailing Instructions

10.1 Sailing instructions will be available Friday afternoon and be posted on the event page on www.yachtscoring.com

11. Awards

- 11.1 Awards for a class with three to four boats registered will be limited to a first-place award.
- 11.2 Awards for a class with five boats registered will be limited to awards for first and second place.
- 11.3 Awards for a class with more than six boats registered with received awards for first, second and third place.

12. Communications

- 12.1 All race day communications will be on VHF #72.
- 12.2 3D race tracking is provided by raceQ's.
- 12.3 Please download the tracking app for iPhone in the Appstore. https://itunes.apple.com/us/app/raceqs
- 12.4 The live regatta will be broadcast at <u>New Years Cup (raceqs.com)</u>

12.5 A replay analysis and commentary will be available via our YouTube channel shortly after the regatta.

13. Penalty System

13.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

14. Disclaimer of Liability

14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15. Insurance

15.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000. per incident or the equivalent.
