## **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

**Newport, RI  
June 25 - 26, 2015**

### **Amendment 1 – June 24<sup>th</sup> 2016 12:15 PM**

#### **Starts and Course Board Description**

All classes will start separately with rolling starts unless the AP is raised during the sequence.

The Course Board will consist of columns and rows with numerals and letters.

The top row will be the class designation with starts order shown from left to right with the class designator numerals “1” through “5”.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> rows are read horizontally under each class or classes.

The second row will consist of the course designator numerals “2” through “7” and optionally the letter “L”.

The third row will consist of the bearing to the windward mark.

The fourth and bottom row will consist of the distance to the windward mark.

Note: While multiple classes may share a course designator all classes will start separately. A vertical line will separate classes with different courses. The order of starts and courses will be announced on VHF channel 73.

## Example Course Board

This course board shows the order of starts as class 2, 1, 3, 4 and then 5.

Classes 2, 1, 3 and 4 sail course 3L with a magnetic bearing to the windward mark of 220 degrees and a leg length of 1.5 nm.

Class 5 sails course 3 with a magnetic bearing to the windward mark of 220 degrees and a leg length of 1.1nm.
