ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority is STUDIOMILANO.

CO-HOSTS

BACARDI Newport Sailing Week and Newport Yacht Club are the co-hosts.

RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)

ADVERTISING

The Organizing Authority may require all participating boats to display sponsor flags and/or stickers in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.3. (d) (i). Boats are encouraged not to display logos or other identification associated with providers of alcoholic beverages other than BACARDI and of banks other than EFG BANK. Other suggested restrictions may apply.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- The BACARDI Newport Sailing Week is open to the boats of the Star, J/70, Viper 640, VX One, A Cat, and Classic Day Racers that meet the obligations of the Class Rules and their National Authority, including current membership.
- Classic Day racers are defined by Panerai Classic Yachts Challenge Rules: Smaller displacement yachts, between 24'-39', with little to no accommodations or auxiliary engine, designed for day sails and inshore racing. CRF rating required.
- Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at www.NewportSailingWeek.com
- On Site Registration: Registration will be located at the BNSW Hospitality Village.
- A minimum of eight boats shall be required for an individual One-Design class start. If minimum class entry requirement is not satisfied, that class may be canceled or consolidated into a mixed fleet to expedite racing at the discretion of the OA.

SUPPORT BOAT and COACH

Support boat and coaching requirements will be specified in the Sailing Instructions.

HOISTING, BERTHING and TRAILER STORAGE

- Competitors can hoist and park trailer at Sail Newport or make alternative arrangements such as our host Club Newport yacht Club (Provider fees apply).
- Berthing at Newport Yacht Club (\$2.00/ft./night).

HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Except for the Star Class all other boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta unless agreed with OA.



RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

INSURANCE

Each boat shall hold adequate insurance including third-party liability insurance, and it is the owner or owners' representative's sole and inescapable responsibility to ensure that the insurance is in place and is adequate prior to participating in this event.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INJURY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk. STUDIOMILANO, Newport Sailing Week, Newport Yacht Club, Bacardi USA, Bacardi Cup, EFG International, Organizing Authority, Sponsors, Support Facilities, Volunteers, Agents, Employees and Service providers, the PRO and the Committee will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Regatta for both on the water and on land activities. By participating in this event, each competitor (owners, skippers, and crews) agrees to release the race organizers and all persons and groups listed above from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

PRIZES

- Overall prizes for the first through third place
- Daily prizes or special awards may be presented at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

MEDIA RIGHTS

Competitors and crew members on the competing yachts grant, at no cost, organizers, sponsors, regatta photographers, videographers and affiliated companies the absolute right and permission to use their name, voice, image, likeness, biographical material and representations of the boats in any media World-wide (including but not limited to television, video, print and electronic media), for the purposes of advertising, promoting, reporting and disseminating information regarding the event and all participants therein.
