NOTICE OF RACE

Heatherton Trophy Race Sunday, July 3, 2016

Organizing Authority: The Shelter Island Yacht Club.

- **1. Rules**: The race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, (RRS) 2013-2016, and the prescriptions of the US Sailing Association, except as changed by this notice, the ELIYA General Conditions and the 2016 Heatherton Trophy Race Sailing Instructions.
- **2. Divisions**: The Race is open to all PHRF class boats with a **current, 2016,** PHRF-ELI Certificate, and that can demonstrate compliance with all requirements of the certificate. There will be both spinnaker and non-spinnaker classes, divided in accordance with the 2016 Heatherton Trophy Race Sailing Instructions.

To facilitate identification by other entrants and the Race Committee, <u>entrants are required to</u> <u>display the class flag for their division from the backstay or from another prominent location if no backstay is available. Yachts not flying a class flag will not be scored and will be disqualified without a hearing. This changes RRS 62.1 (a).</u>

Note: If at least three boats of a one design class enter to race, using the class one design rating, they will be scored as a class as well as within the appropriate division, e.g., J105s racing as a class as well as in division I.

3. Scoring: PHRF, Time on Time Scoring.

4. Start Times: (See RRS, Part 3. 26 Starting Races)

The first warning signal will be at **1300**. The warning signal for subsequent classes shall be made with or after the starting signal of the preceding class.

- **5. The Start**: Between an Orange Flag on the Race Committee Boat and a red ball or an inflatable mark set in Gardiners Bay 1 nm East of RW "N" Mo(A) WHIS.
- **6. The Finish**: Between an Orange Flag on the Race Committee Boat and a red ball, or an inflatable mark or Government mark set in the location indicated under Courses in the Sailing Instructions.
- **7. Courses**: The Course(s) will be announced on the day of the race using drop marks and/or government buoys as defined in the Sailing Instructions. The Race Committee may elect to provide a different course for **all or some** divisions.

- **8. Sailing Instructions**: The Sailing Instructions will be available at least one week prior to the race, on www.yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=2844 and www.siyc.com.
- **9. Changes to the Notice of Race:** Any amendments to the Notice of Race will be posted on the Yacht Scoring website and the SIYC website.
- **10. Communications**: The Race Committee will monitor VHF Channels 72 and 68. Boats shall carry an operating VHF radio capable of receiving weather bulletins and communications from the Race Committee as well as communicating any emergency on board.

In the event of an emergency, contact the Race Committee on Chanel 68.

- 11. Time Limit: Four hours from the start time for each division.
- 12. RRS Rule 52 will not be enforced.
- **13. Safety:** It is recommended that all boats be compliant with the current US Safety Equipment Requirements (USSER) Near Shore categories. These regulations are available on the US Sailing website.
- **14. Entries**: Entry fee: \$75.00.

Entries <u>must</u> be made on <u>www.yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=2844</u>. Please complete the entry carefully and do not neglect to indicate in which Division you intend to race and to sign the waiver.

A copy of the boat's 2016 PHRF-ELI certificate must be received by the race committee before an entry will be considered final.
