NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Racing rule 61 will be changed to require boats to notify the Race Committee immediately after finishing of their intent to protest
- 1.3 Class weight limits are waived.
- 1.4 Each boat shall carry a radio capable of transmitting and receiving VHF channel 73.



2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to PHRF monohull boats that are 24-50 feet LOA, and all one-design keelboats with four or more entries between 19-35 feet LOA.

3 FEES

The entry fee for all classes is \$50. Online entry is preferred however entry by fax is acceptable. Completed entries must be received no later than 1600 on 11 August 2016. Paper entries will be accepted with an additional \$25 charge. Online registration and electronic entry fee payment are available at yachtscoring.com. Entries received after this date will be accepted if they include a \$25 late fee.

4 RACE FORMAT

The regatta will consist of one race, course set around government marks.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Date of race: Saturday, August 13, 2016 - warning at 1430 at Can "1" NE of Execution Rocks
- 5.2 Number of races: All classes one race per day.

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid PHRF rating certificate. PHRF certificates from other areas will be adjusted to conform to the YRA of LIS. The race committee based upon best available information will assign PHRF handicaps for boats not rated by the YRA of LIS.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 0900 on 11 August 2016 at Huguenot Yacht Club and on Yachtscoring.com

8 VENUE and COURSES

- 8.1 At 1430, Saturday, 13 August 2016 the rendezvous for the start will be at Green Can "1" 0.8 nm north of Execution
- 8.2 The courses for the race will be a course set around government marks from the start, around specified government marks and then to the finish.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

For the all classes rule 44.1 and 44.2 is changed so that the One-Turn Penalty replaces the Two-Turns Penalty.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 The PHRF classes will be scored using time on time, using $TCF = 650 / (550 + PHRF)$.
- 10.2 One-design classes will be scored by order of finish as per Appendix A.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 11.1 Race information will be given on VHF Channel 73.
- 11.2 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: Daily Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$100,000.00 per incident or the equivalent.

15 EVENT PARTY

All participants are invited to a barbecue party on the lawn of Huguenot Yacht Club following the races at a cost of \$20 per dinner (\$15 for ages 12 and under).
