Sailing Instruction

Amendment 1

Change the schedule of Races SI #5 as follows:

SCHEDULE OF RACES

| Class | Warning | Start | Class Flag |
|--------------------|----------|----------|-------------|
| Multihull | 1000 hrs | 1005 hrs | Pennant "1" |
| Bareboat | 1005 hrs | 1010 hrs | Pennant "2" |
| Cruising | 1010 hrs | 1015 hrs | Pennant "3" |
| Racing | 1015 hrs | 1020 hrs | Pennant "4" |
| Offshore Multihull | 1020 hrs | 1025 hrs | Pennant "5" |

A time check will be performed on the race channel prior to the first warning signal.

THE START

The starting sequence will be in accordance with rule 26. The Race Committee will attempt to inform competitors who are OCS on **VHF channel 69**. Failure to do so, or failure of a competitor to hear or receive such transmissions will not be grounds for redress. There will be no penalty for late starters.

THE COURSE

For all classes. Start in Sir Francis Drake Channel between an orange flag on the Signal Boat and the course side of a nearby inflatable mark. Leave Pelican Island, the Indians and all mooring balls to port, round Norman Island leaving it to port finishing off Nanny Cay between the course side of an inflatable mark and a blue flag displayed at Nanny Cay Beach Stage.

This modifies both the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
