AMENDMENT NO. 1**

(Amendments in Italics)

- 1.1 ***IS AMENDED TO READ:*** The LTYC Regatta and One-Design Series will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012, the prescriptions of US SAILING, *the 2010 IRC Rule, Parts A, B & C (Division 1), the 2010 Lake Michigan PHRF Rule (Divisions II & III)* and, for the One-Design Series, the Class Rules of the competing classes, except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions. The Race Committee has full authority to conduct the races.
- 3.1 ***IS AMENDED TO READ:*** The LTYC Regatta is open to Offshore Racer/Cruiser type yachts of 25' LOA and invited one design classes.
*Division I is IRC and includes boats with a rating of 1.105 or higher.
Division II is PHRF and includes boats with a minimum LMPHRF handicap of 50 and a maximum of 132.
Boats that fall in a gap between, or in neither Division I or II may be assigned to a division following consultation with LTYC.
Division III is PHRF, main & jib, of any LMPHRF handicap. The Alerion 26 Class will sail I Division III as a separate class.*

Friday	July 30	Between 1600 and 1800 Hours	Sign in at LTYC. Receive Sailing Instructions.
Friday	July 30	1700 Hours	Irish Boat Shop party with Beer, Band, Brats, and Banter.
Saturday	July 31	1030 Hours	<i>Warning Signal for Class A, Division I followed by other classes in alphabetical order. (Division II following Division I classes; Division III following Division II classes.)</i>
Saturday	July 31	After Racing	Complimentary Dinner Buffet & snacks, Dutch treat cocktail party at LTYC.
Sunday	August 1	1030 Hours	Warning Signal for the first race. More races to follow.
Sunday	August 1	After Racing	Race results, awards, Complimentary Buffet & Dutch-treat cocktail party at LTYC.

6.3 **IS AMENDED TO READ:**

The following are required for registration and entry:

- a. Completed Entry Form
- b. Signed Conditions Statement and Release Agreement
- c. A valid 2010 *Rating or Handicap* Certificate
- d. Payment of required fees
- e. Any class specific entry material (sail inventory, crew weight, etc.) must be supplied to designated class officer.
- f. Pick up of Race Packet/Sailing Instructions at Registration.
