1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Notice to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at https://yachtscoring.com/notice board.cfm?eid=4060.

3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any changes to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0900 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 2000 on the day before it will take effect.

4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 4.1. Signals made ashore will be from the club flag staff.
- 4.2. When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 90 minutes' in the signal AP.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

First Start 1100

6. THE START

- 6.1. Starting times will be listed in addendum A following these instructions.
- 6.2. The Starting Area will be approximately due east of North Avenue Beach.
- 6.3. Boats are required to check in with the committee boat.
- 6.4. The starting line will be bi-directional, meaning racers will be able to start in a northbound or southbound direction. The line will be divided into two sections split in the middle by the committee boat.
- 6.5. **Northbound**; sailors shall start west of the committee boat (between North Avenue Beach the committee boat). Your starting line will be between a yellow mushroom and an orange flag on the committee boat.
- 6.6. **Southbound**; sailors shall start East of the committee boat (between the committee boat and the cribs) your starting line will be between an orange flag on the committee boat and a white mushroom.

6.7. Recall and OCS:

- 6.7.1. If any part of a boat's hull, crew or equipment crosses the starting line during the five-minute period before its assigned start time; she will receive a 10-minute penalty without a hearing (this modifies RRS 63.1 and A5). She need not return to start properly, but shall proceed to sail the course. This modifies RRS 28.1 and 29.1.
- 6.7.2. No recall signals or hails will be made. This modifies RRS 29.
- 6.8. Failure of a boat to see or hear her recall notification, and the timing and order of such hails, or the length of time it takes to make a notification on the VHF radio channel 69 will not be grounds for redress. (This changes RRS 29.1 and 62.1 (a).)

7. THE COURSE

7.1. Northbound

Three course marks to be passed on STARBOARD are:

1st mark- Wilson Avenue Crib;

2nd mark -a polyhedron placed approximately 2 miles east of Harrison Deever Crib and (N41.55.592 W87.32.038)

3rd mark - the 4 Mile Crib Approximately East of Columbia Yacht Club.

7.2. Southbound

Three course marks to be passed on PORT are:

1st mark- the 4 Mile Crib Approximately East of Columbia Yacht Club.;

2nd mark –A polyhedron placed approximately 2 miles east of Harrison Deever Crib (N41.55.592 W87.32.038) and

3rd mark - Wilson Avenue Crib

7.3. Restricted areas around all cribs must be obeyed. Violators will be disqualified without a hearing.

8. THE FINISH

- 8.1. The finish area will be east of North Avenue Beach where the race started. The finish line for boats starting and sailing in the Northbound course shall finish between the yellow mushroom (located West of the committee boat) and the orange flag on the committee boat. The finish line for boats starting and sailing in the Southbound course shall be between the orange flag on the committee boat and the white mushroom (located east of the committee boat). Boats must pass between their respective finish marks and the committee boat to properly finish
- 8.2. Boats are requested to note their finish times, boat finishing before, and boat finishing behind.

9. TIME LIMIT

- 9.1. The time limit is 1600hrs.
- 9.2. Please hail the race committee on VHF channel 69 if you are approaching the finish after 1500hrs.
- 9.3. Please notify the race committee on VHF channel 69 if you intend on retiring prior to 1600hrs.

10. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 10.1. Protests forms are available at the race office located on the Rail Deck of Columbia Yacht Club. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered there within the appropriate time limit.
- 10.2. For each class, the protest time limit is 90 minutes after the last boat has finished.
- 10.3. Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of the hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses. Hearings will be held on the Rail Deck of Columbia Yacht Club.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILLITY

Competitors participating in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for the material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
