CHANGES & ADDENDUM TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS, 6.13.17

Supersedes Sailing Instruction #7: The Course, Amendment #1

An inflatable tetrahedron (triangle shaped) orange mark (designated as the "T" mark or "Tango") may be used as a windward mark for Section 4 (Grand Touring).*

*This is to allow a windward mark rounding in a direction that may differ from the other sections.

Replace with:

Sailing Instruction #7: The Course, Amendment #2

An inflatable tetrahedron (triangle shaped) orange mark (designated as the "T" mark or "Tango") may be used as a drop mark for all sections.

Among the uses of the "Tango" mark:

- * Allow a windward mark rounding for a designated in a direction that may differ from the other sections.
- * Can be used as an turning mark or finish mark if the RC chooses to shorten course. (Example: a YC/R8/YC/R8/YC windward/leeward could be shortened to YC/R8/YC/T/YC with the Tango mark placed half-way between YC and R8)
