## NOTICE OF RACE & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

**1 – RULES** - The race will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS) and the prescriptions of the US Sailing Association (US Sailing). The rules may be altered by this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.

**2 – ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY** - All sailors are welcome.

**3 – FEES** – The entry fee for The Nan-C-Jay are included in fees paid for any competitor who has registered and paid for the Spring, Summer, and/or Twilight Series, of the GTYC Wednesday Night Race. Previously unregistered competitors are welcome and may register for a fee of \$10 at the GTYC Bar prior to 1730 hrs, Wednesday, August 29.

### 4 -- SCORING

4.1 Results will be based on a calculation of a yacht's time elapsed time corrected by their PHRF rating, as registered for the 2018 GTYC Wednesday Night Series, modified by the addition of 10 seconds per point (as defined by the rules of the American Cornhole Association) scored in the onshore "cornhole" portion of the event.

### 5 – SCHEDULE

1700 hrs      Registration closes Wednesday, August 29, 1700 hrs

1755 hrs      First Warning, All Sections: 1755 hrs

45 Minutes after docking of Signal Boat: All "cornhole" scores must be recorded

## **6 – COURSE & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

6.1 - The Nan-C-Jay will be contested as a single class event & start.

6.2 - The sailing race course will be communicated by the Race Committee from the signal boat. The official communication of the race course is the whiteboard displayed on the aft end of the signal boat. As a courtesy, the race course will also be communicated by radio on VHF Ch. 69 and by text.

### *6.3 - Cornhole Rating Modifier*

6.3.1 - All yachts participating in the 2018 Nan-C-Jay have the opportunity to modify their registered PHRF rating by the tossing of eight (8) “cornhole” bags by two crew members who sailed on the yacht during the sailing portion of the race.

6.3.2 - Each of the two designated crew members may toss a maximum of four (4) bags for a total of eight (8) per yacht.

6.3.3 - All “cornhole” equipment and venue set-up will be provided by the GTYC Race Committee. These sailing instructions and purviews of the GTYC Race Committee may supersede the rules of the American Cornhole Association.

6.3.4 - All “cornhole” scores will be recorded by members of the Race Committee

6.3.5 - Scoring per bag tossed will be as follows

a. bag that remains on the board: 1 point

b. bag that falls entirely through the hole: 3 points

6.3.6 - 10 seconds of PHRF rating will be added per “cornhole” point scored to the registered PHRF rating of the competition yacht.

6.3.7 - All “cornhole” scores must be recorded by the Race Committee by 45 minutes after the Signal Boat of the Race Committee has docked.

**7 – SIGNALS MADE ASHORE** – Will be communicated to competitors over VHF Channel 69. If you have any question regarding the status of a race, call or text the Principal Race Officer @ 231.883.5741

## **8 -- PRIZES**

The Nan-C-Jay Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner determined by order of finish and will be recognized after the race. The top Jib & Main finisher will also be recognized. If the top Jib & Main competitor has the best corrected time of all competitors, they will be awarded the Nan-C-Jay Perpetual Trophy
