NOTICE OF RACE



1 RULES

- 1.1 The series races will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the US Sailing national authority will apply.
- 1.3 No single-handed racing is allowed.
- 1.4 All yachts shall comply with Lake Huron PHRF By-Laws and have a valid PHRF Certificate per registration.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats shall display advertising in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20- ISAF Advertising Code.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Boats shall be entered by completing registration form or signing up on www.yachtscoring.com per Section 5.
- 3.2 Yachts must register for each race day individually.

4 FEES

- 4.1 There is a \$10 racing fees for Friendship or Memorial Races to cover Yachtscoring charge.

5 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 5.1 Friendship Race and Ed Schwanz Memorial Race Sign-up will close at 2000 on Friday.
- 5.2 Friendship Race is on Saturday.
- 5.3 The Ed Schwanz Memorial Race is on Sunday.
- 5.4 See individual SI's for warning signal times.
- 5.5 Awards will be after racing each day at PHYC.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 The sailing instructions will be available after August 29th on www.yachtscoring.com.
- 6.2 Final SI's will be posted at the Notice Boards.

7 CLASSES

- 7.1 Classes
 - 7.1.1 PHRF – Shall race in accordance with Lake Huron PHRF By-Laws.
 - 7.1.2 ASM - Shall race in accordance with Lake Huron PHRF By-Laws ASM Section
 - 7.1.3 JAM - Shall race in accordance with Lake Huron PHRF By-Laws Jib and Main Section
 - 7.1.4 One Design Classes will be held per design rules.
- 7.2 Minimum yachts to form a class are five (5).
- 7.3 Registered yachts cannot change class after late sign up times for each race day.
- 7.4 Yachts without a valid LH PHRF rating will be assigned a rating for the weekend by LH PHRF. This rating is final.

8 THE COURSES

- 8.1 The Friendship Race will be a set buoy course.
- 8.2 The Memorial will be a point to point course.

9 PRIZES

- 9.1 Flags will be given to the top three finishers in each class on both days.
- 9.2 See SI's for additional awards.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 10.1 Competitors participate in the races entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the races.

11 INSURANCE

- 11.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
