NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

1.1 This event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The prescriptions of the Canadian national authority, Sail Canada, will apply. A copy of the prescriptions can be found here; http://www.sailing.ca/files/SC_Prescrip_Arbit_2013_16.pdf

2. ELIGIBILITY:

2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Melges and J105.

2.3 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: Each fleet must have a minimum of 6 entries to be eligible to compete in the Melges 20 Canadians & Fall Keelboat Regatta.

3. ENTRY AND FEES:

3.1 The Organizing Authority must receive the completed online entry form by Friday September 8.

3.2 Entry fees are as follows;

Melges Fleet: \$120 + HST (price includes 6 drink tickets for Saturday night)
J105 Fleet: \$150 + HST (price includes 10 drink tickets for Saturday night)

4. SCHEDULE:

Date	Time	Event
Saturday June 3	1050 hours	1st Warning Signal. Subsequent races to follow
Sunday June 4	1030 hours	1st Warning Signal. Subsequent races to follow
Sunday June 4	1430 hours	No warning signal to be made after this time
Sunday June 4	1530 - 1630	Prize giving as soon as possible following racing

4.2 Number of races:

A maximum of 7 races are scheduled for each fleet. (4 on Saturday, 3 on Sunday).

5 MEASUREMENT:

5.1 Each boat shall hold a valid measurement certificate.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

6.1 The sailing instructions will be available after 1200hrs on September 6.

7 VENUE:

7.1 The Melges 20 Canadians & Fall Keelboat Regatta will be hosted from the Royal Canadian Yacht Clubs Island Facility. A ferry from 150 Cherry Street runs to the Island at quarter to and quarter past the hour. It returns to Cherry Street on the hour. 7.2 Attachment A shows the location of the racing areas.

8 Scoring:

8.1 The Low Point System, RRS Appendix A will apply.

8.2 Two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

8.3 A) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8.3 B) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst scores.

8.4 There will be no drop race for the J-105 fleet.

9 BERTHING:

9.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while at the Club.

10 HAUL OUT RESTRICTIONS:

10.1 Keelboats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with written permission of the race committee.

11 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS:

11.1 Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keelboats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

12 RADIO COMMUNICATION:

12.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13. PRIZES AND AWARDS:

13.1 Prizes will be given as follows: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers as well as any other prizes the organizers deem deserved.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15 INSURANCE:

15.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$2 000 000 CAD per incident. A copy of the policy shall be kept on board.

16 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

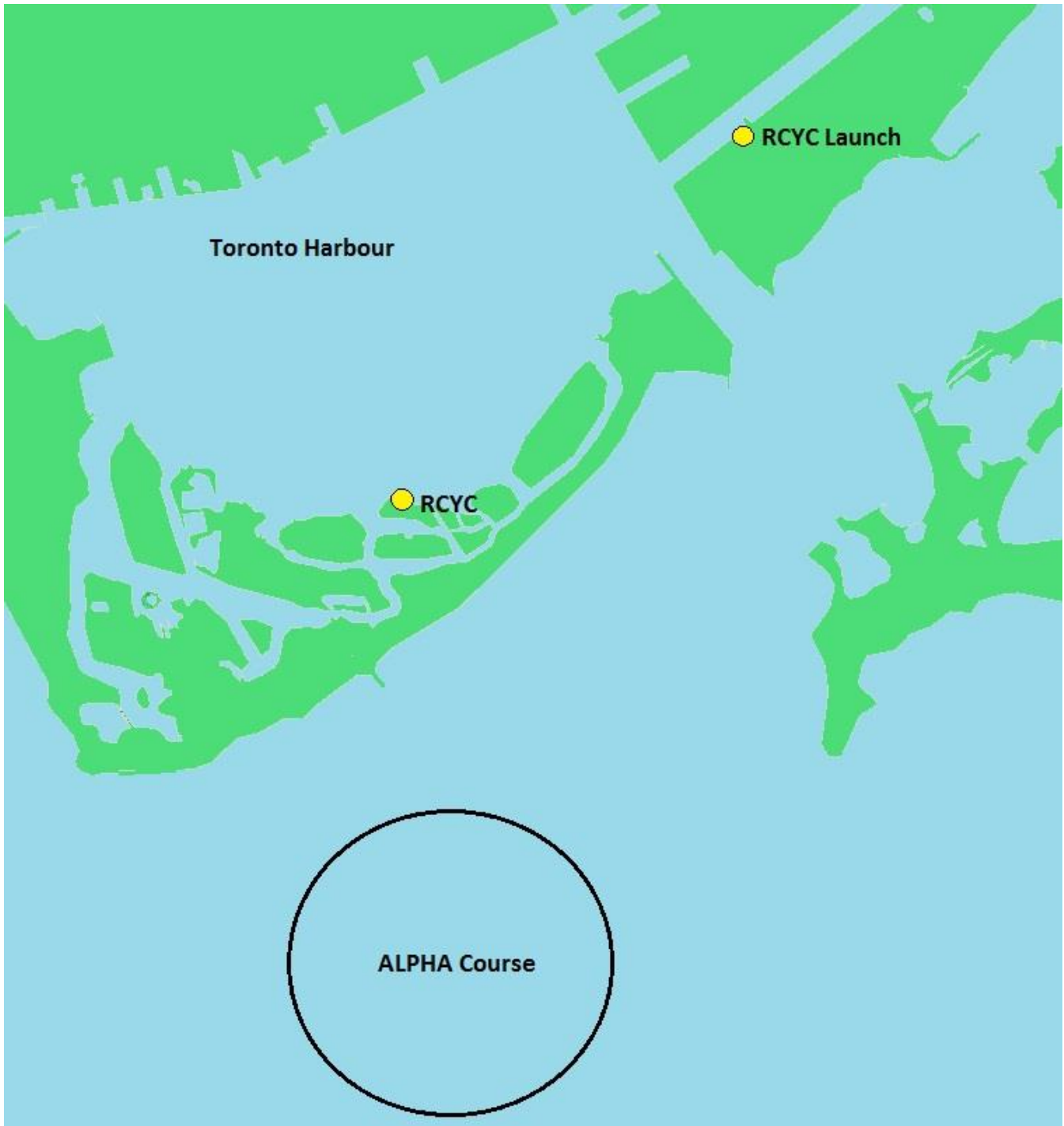
