Eligibility: This race is open to sail yachts owned or chartered by individual members of clubs or associations that are members in good standing of ABYRA, DRYA, or US Sailing, and who have paid their race fees.

Registration: Registration shall be submitted online with www.yachtscoring.com, (link to registration instructions on the **NSSC web site www.NorthStarSail.org/Racing**). **Series Fee is \$85.00 (to sail Race 1 Howard Boston Mem. only \$35.00)**. Completed entry forms shall be received by 1200 on the day prior to the event. Late entries will be accepted and will be subject to a \$5.00 late fee.

Classes: JAM, Asymmetrical, and Spinnaker classes Class splits will be posted at NSSC clubhouse no later than 2 hours before the race. Five boats are required for a one-design or double-handed start.

Schedule: The warning signal for the first start is scheduled for 1100 each race day.

Ratings: If a boat does not have a current DRYA rating certificate, the RC will assign a temporary rating as described in the ABYRA Handbook.

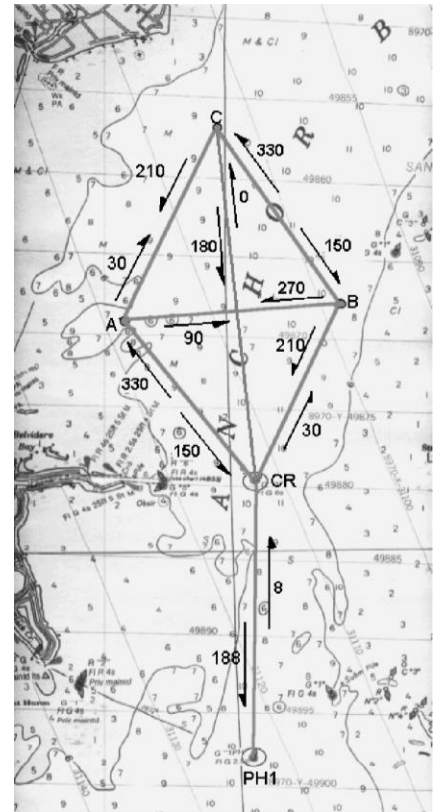
Sailing Instructions: Sailing instructions will be posted on YachtScoring.com (also available through the NSSC web site NorthStarSail.org/Racing) by 0900 the morning of the first race. Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted by 0900 on the day of the race. It is the responsibility of each competitor to check the online notice board for notices.

Course: Courses will be on Anchor Bay in Lake St. Clair. Course configurations and visual signals are described in the Sailing Instructions. Course selection will be visually communicated to competitors prior to the warning signal. Courses are a mix of windward/leeward, modified Olympic, and triangle. The intention is to run as many races over the four days of the regatta as possible.

Scoring: Races will be scored using order of finish for one-design classes and time-on-time over PHRF for other classes and division overall.

Food and Awards: Breakfast available before each race day. The grill will be open following the races on Oct 1, 8, and 15. Saturday, October 21, is the NSSC **Octoberfest** - food, awards, and other entertainment till the wee hours. **Daily class awards** will be presented each race day at North Star Sail Club, 32041 S. River Rd., Harrison Twp., MI, 48045. Series and class overall flags will be presented on the final race day.
