NOTICE OF RACE

The organizing authority is Etchells Fleet 20. Coral Reef Yacht Club is the host club.

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The race will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and the rules of the International Etchells Class Association (IECA) as amended by this notice of race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The following US Sailing prescriptions will apply: 40, 61.4, 67, 76.1, and Appendix R.
- 1.3. Skippers shall be Active members and crew Associate or Active members of the IECA.
- 1.4. The penalty for breaking a rule of Part 2 when outside of the three (3) boat length zone is changed to a one turn penalty including one tack and one jibe. This changes RRS 44.1.
- 1.5. The International Etchells Class Rules are changed as follows: All competing boats shall carry a hand held VHF radio for safety purposes and race committee communication. The use of mobile telephones and other electronic communication devices is prohibited.

2. ADVERTISING:

Advertising will be restricted to International Sailing Federation (ISAF) Category A.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the International Etchells Class.
- 3.2. Competitors shall comply with the rules of the IECA, and ISAF Regulation 19.
- 3.3. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration by March 16, 2018 and paying the required fees at: <https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=4586>

4. FEES:

- 4.1. The entry fee is \$375.00 per boat if received by March 4th, 2018, and \$450.00 thereafter.
- 4.2. There is a \$75.00 supplemental fee for a fourth crew member.

5. SCHEDULE:

Saturday, March 17, 2018:	1100 Warning signal first race Additional races to follow
Sunday, March 18, 2018	1100 Warning signal first race Additional races to follow No warning after 1430.

6. MEASUREMENT:

6.1. Boats, rigs, and sails will not be measured but shall be in compliance with IECA.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing instructions will be available at the time of registration/check-in and may be posted in advance on the event web site.

8. VENUE:

The sailing venue will be Biscayne Bay, Coconut Grove, Florida.

9. COURSES:

9.1. The race course configurations will be Windward - Leeward with offset marks, and gates.

10. PENALTIES:

10.1. The penalty for breaking a rule of Part 2 when outside of the three (3) boat leight zone is changed where the penalty will be a one turn penalty including one tack and one jibe. This changes RRS 44.1.

11. SCORING:

11.1. Eight races are scheduled with four completed races required to constitute the championship.

11.2. The Low Point System, Appendix A - Scoring, will apply. After five races, have been completed a boat's worst score will be excluded.

12. SUPPORT BOATS:

- 12.1. Support boats shall register at the registration/check-in desk. Identifying flags may be issued and if issued shall be displayed at all times while on the water.
- 12.2. Team leaders, coaches, and other support personnel shall not communicate with any competitor during a race in any manner, unless assisting in an emergency. Support boats shall stay well outside of the starting and racing area from the time of a warning signal until all boats have finished the race, or until the Race Committee signals a postponement, general recall, or abandonment.
- 12.3. Support boats shall have on board a working VHF radio and shall actively monitor the Race Committee on Channel 71.
- 12.4. Support boats shall comply with all instructions from the Race Committee and those set forth in the Sailing Instructions.

13. HAUL - OUT RESTRICTIONS:

- 13.1. Boats shall be afloat no later than the warning signal for the first race Friday, March 16, 2018.
- 13.2. Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta without written permission from the Race Committee. This changes RRS 45.

14. PRIZES:

- 14.1. Coral Reef Cup Perpetual (remains in custody of CRYC) skipper and crew.
- 14.2. First through fifth place overall, skipper and crew.
- 14.3. The Organizing Authority may provide additional prizes.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority, the race committee, the International Etchells Class, and sponsors will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16. INSURANCE:

Each participating boat is required to hold adequate insurance including a minimum of \$300,000 third-party insurance, and it is the owner's sole and inescapable responsibility to ensure that the insurance is in place and is adequate prior to participating in this event. PROOF OF INSURANCE SHALL BE SUPPLIED WITH EACH ENTRY AT REGISTRATION.
