**Chicago Regatta Casual Race  
Amendment No. 1**

The Chicago Regatta Casual Race shall take place on Saturday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>, beginning at 1245 hours.  
**This amends Casual Race Notice of Series No. 1.**

The course for the Chicago Regatta Casual Race shall be as follows:

Start (Appx. 090° T, 0.9 NM from Belmont Harbor Light (CASRA Starting Area B)

87°36.85 W

First Mark (Harrison Dever Crib) (round crib/guard marks to PORT)

41°54.59 N

87°34.23 W

Second Mark (Wilson Avenue Crib) (round crib to PORT)

41°57.97 N

87°35.47 W

Third Mark (Orange Mark located at CASRA Starting Area B) (round mark to PORT)

41°54.59 N

87°34.23 W

Fourth Mark (Wilson Avenue Crib) (round crib to PORT)

41°57.97 N

87°35.47 W

Finish (Appx. 090° T, 0.9 NM from Belmont Harbor Light (CASRA Starting Area B)

41°56.50 N

87°36.85 W

Finish between the orange mark and the Race Committee boat.

**This amends CASRA Casual Sailing Instruction No. 6 and No. 8.**

Boats shall file protests and requests for redress at the Protest Desk at Chicago Yacht Club – Belmont Station within the appropriate time limit. A boat’s protest time limit is 60 minutes from the docking time of the race committee boat that finished her. **This amends CASRA Casual Sailing Instruction No. 13.2.**

The time limit for this race shall be 1630 hours. **This amends CASRA Casual Sailing Instruction No. 12.**

All Chicago Regatta Casual Race participants are invited to join Chicago Yacht Club for its annual Big Kahuna Party at **Belmont Station**, immediately following the Chicago Regatta Casual Race. Chicago Regatta brag flags will be awarded to boats placing first, second, and third in spinnaker and non-spinnaker divisions. The Big Kahuna Party will feature authentic Hawaiian drinks, food, and entertainment. Come join your fellow sailors at Belmont, toast the winners, and celebrate the end of a great CASRA Casual Race Season!
