

# NOTICE OF RACE

**2011 Melges 32 Gold Cup** December 2-4 | Fort Lauderdale, F.L.

The Melges 32 Gold Cup Regatta will be hosted by the Lauderdale Yacht Club in association with the International Melges 32 Class Association (IM32CA), supported by Melges USA, Wednesday through Sunday, November 30 - December 4, 2011. Lauderdale Yacht Club is located at 1725 SE 12th Street, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33316, 1+ (954) 524-5500. ## 1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The "class rules" for the purposes of the definition of "rules" are the International Melges 32 Class Rules (IM32CR).
- 1.3 The Organizing Authority (OA) is Lauderdale Yacht Club.
- 1.4 All boats must carry minimum equipment as required by the U.S. Coast Guard and the IM32CR.
- 1.5 Advertising shall only be displayed in accordance with the ISAF Advertising Code (see ISAF Regulation 20).

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

2.1 The Melges 32 Gold Cup shall be open to boats whose Owner or Skipper is a current member of their National Governing Body (US SAILING for US entries; to join USSA call 1-800-USSAIL-1) and the International Melges 32 Class Association (IM32CA).

#### NOTICE OF RACE 2011 MELGES 32 GOLD CUP

- 2.2 Owners and crews must meet all ISAF and IM32CA rules.
- 2.3 Each entrant must submit a completed Entry Form online via Yachtscoring (<a href="http://yachtscoring.com">http://yachtscoring.com</a>) by Friday, November 11 and pay the entry fee no later than Friday, November 18, 2011. Original signatures must be provided at registration. Late entries will be accepted only with the prior approval of the OA.

#### 3. REGISTRATION

- 3.1 To complete registration, all entrants shall have submitted all required class forms, paid all entry fees and submitted a completed Entry Form and Signed Release Agreement with original signature.
- 3.2 Only boats that have fully completed registration by 1900 hours on Friday, November 18, 2011 will be eligible to race. Late registration may be allowed only with the prior approval of the OA and will be subject to late entry fees pursuant to 4 below.

#### 4. FEES

The entry fee will be \$1,250 per boat for entries received by Friday, November 11, 2011 plus a \$150 class administration fee. The fee for entries received after that date will be \$1,350 USD plus a \$150 class administration fee. Fees can be paid by credit card on line at (<a href="http://yachtscoring.com">http://yachtscoring.com</a>). Checks must be drawn on a U.S. bank and made payable to the Lauderdale Yacht Club.

#### 5. CLASSIFICATION

- 5.1 The ISAF Classification Code, Regulation 22, will apply. Details of the ISAF classification Code and information on how to apply can be found on the ISAF website at www.sailing.org/classification.
- 5.2 No later than Friday, November 18, 2011, each entrant shall submit a completed Crew Declaration Form (IM32CR Appendix 3.1) to Joy Dunigan, IM32CA Administrator at <a href="mailto:classadmin@melges32.com">classadmin@melges32.com</a> or fax to +1 (912) 756-6728 for verification. The Crew Declaration Form should list all crew, together with their classification and, for Group 1 sailors, their ISAF Sailor ID number.
- 5.3 All Crew Declaration Forms will be posted online at <a href="https://www.melges32.com">www.melges32.com</a>, upon receipt.
- The earliest time a classification protest may be submitted is 0900 EDT hours on Friday, November 11, 2011. The Classification Protests Time Limit under ISAF Regulation 22.1 is 1700 hours on Friday, November 25, 2011.
- 5.5 A boat will not be eligible to race until all crew classifications have been checked for compliance.

Eight (8) races are scheduled: The Race Committee (RC) may run fewer races at its discretion and may make up a race on Sunday if needed.

#### 7. MEASUREMENT

- 7.1 Each entrant must provide a completed Yacht Owner Compliance Declaration (IM32CR Appendix 4) to Joy Dunigan, IM32CA Administrator, via e-mail at <a href="mailto:classadmin@melges32.com">classadmin@melges32.com</a> or via fax at +1 (912) 756-6728 by Thursday, December 1.
- 7.2 Each entrant must provide a completed Sail Declaration Form (IM32CR Appendix 3.2) to Joy Dunigan, IM32C Administrator by the close of registration (1800) on Thursday December 1.
- 7.3 Each entrant must submit a completed Crew Weigh-In/Liability Form (IM32CR Appendix5) to Joy Dunigan, IM32CA Administrator by the close of registration (1800) on ThursdayDecember 1.
- 7.4 All competitors shall weigh-in during the following times: 0800 1000 on Wednesday, November 30, 0800 1000 and 1600 1800 on Thursday, December 1. Late weigh-in on Friday December 2 from 0800 0830 is by appointment only.

#### 8. Replacement of Crew

- 8.1 Crew substitutions before and during the event are permitted. A revised crew list must be submitted to Joy Dunigan, IM32CA Administrator and approval received prior to the race to which it applies.
- 8.2 Crew substitutions may weigh-in during the designated Substitute Crew Weigh-In period, from 0800 0830 hours, on the first day that they will compete.

#### 9. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Boats shall not be hauled-out during the regatta except with prior written permission of the protest committee and subject to the terms of the written permission. All boats shall be launched prior to 1200 hrs.. Thursday, December 01, 2011.

#### 10. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be provided to entrants during registration.

## **11. VENUE**

The racing area will be the Atlantic Ocean south of the Port Everglades inlet. Further information will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 12. THE COURSES

Courses will be windward / leeward.

#### 13. PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS 44.1 is modified by adding the following: Except for a starting mark, the turns penalty for a Part 2 rule broken inside the *Zone* shall be a Two-Turns Penalty as prescribed in this rule without modification. The turns penalty for a Part 2 rule broken outside the *Zone* shall be One Turn, including one tack and one gybe. This changes RRS 44.1.

#### 14. SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply, with the following modification: when fewer than six races have been sailed, a boat's series score will be the total of all her race scores; when six or more races have been sailed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. Eight (8) races are scheduled; three (3) races must be completed to constitute a regatta.

#### 15. SUPPORT BOATS

- 15.1 IMR32R Section I.5 is invoked regarding restriction on support boats.
- 15.2 Only support boats that have registered with the RC and carry identification provided by the RC will be allowed in the racing area.

#### 16. RADIO COMMUNICATION

#### **NOTICE OF RACE 2011 MELGES 32 GOLD CUP**

- 16.1 While on the water, the RC may communicate with competing boats via VHF radio, including starting penalties.
- 16.2 Each competing boat shall carry a radio capable of transmitting and receiving VHF channel 69.

## 17. LYC Sailing Foundation Junior Race Day

- 17.1 Experienced local junior sailors will be randomly assigned to race on each yacht for racing on Saturday. These junior sailors will not be included for calculation of class weight restrictions.
- 17.2 The junior sailor aboard the yacht with the lowest total points during Saturday's racing will be recognized with an award from the LYC Sailing Foundation during the Commodore's Banquet.

#### 18. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded after racing on Sunday to boats placing first through fifth overall.

#### 19. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for this event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
