



STAMFORD YACHT CLUB Kathleen's Cup Race

August 25, 2018

NOTICE OF RACE

Stamford Yacht Club, the Organizing Authority of this event, is sponsoring a commemorative yacht race in keeping with its first inter-club contest sailed in 1893.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The US Sailing prescriptions to the RRS will apply.
- 1.3 The current YRALIS PHRF Regulations for non-spinnaker.
- 1.4 The Current YRALIS Minimum Equipment & Safety Recommendations for Category C.
- 1.5 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located on YachtScoring www.yachtscoring.com .

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats holding a current YRALIS PHRF Rating Certificate.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the process on the event page on YachtScoring.com www.yachtscoring.com by 1800 on Tuesday, August 21st.
- 2.3 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee.

3 FEES

Entry fees are as follows:

\$1.00 per foot rounded down: (i.e., 29'-10" = 29 X \$1.00)

4 QUALIFYING EVENT

The race is a qualifier for a day of enjoying the beauty of sailing, a dinner and drinks with your friends, and dancing with your favorite partner.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Racing is scheduled for Saturday, August 25th with the first warning signal intended for 1300.
- 5.2 Boats will sail one race.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on YachtScoring.com on or before 1200 on Tuesday, August 21st.

7 VENUE

- 7.1 Racing will be conducted on the waters of Long Island Sound. The location of the starting line will be in the vicinity of Red Bell 32 "The Cows."
- 7.2 After race reception will be on the Vineyard Deck at Stamford Yacht Club.

8 THE COURSE

The course to be sailed will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

Scoring penalties will be in accordance with RRS V1 and V2.

10 SCORING

A boat's score will be determined by multiplying her PHRF rating converted to a Time-on-Time value by multiplying (650/550+PHRF) by her elapsed time.

11 COMMUNICATION

- 11.1 The Official Notice Board will be on YachtScoring.com.
- 11.2 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice nor data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication not simultaneously available to all boats. [DP]
- 11.3 The race committee will monitor and broadcast on VHF Channel 05A.

12 PRIZES

- 12.1 A prize will be given for the overall winner.
- 12.2 Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
