

1.1 White Group Boats will start on the Black Group start line for this Regatta

All radio communications will be on the Black Group VHF channel 72, unless Sailing Instruction 5.3 applies. Sailing Instructions 5.2 and 7.3 will not apply.

2.1 Royal Southern buoy – temporary new position 50° 48.68N, 01° 16.02W

Attention is drawn to the ABP Notice to Mariners No 41(T) of 2019 stating that Royal Southern buoy has been moved temporarily to a new position at 50° 48.68N, 01° 16.02W due to the ongoing IFA cable works. That is about 0.35NM bearing 235° from its original position as listed in the Royal Southern YC Solent Mark Codes 2019 list.

(Note for future reference: the buoy is expected to be in its temporary location until November, when it will be moved to a new permanent location at 50° 48.86N, 01° 15.43W, which is about 0.09NM bearing about 102° from its original position).
