Notice of Race

1 RULES

- 1.1 All races organized by the Buffalo Small Boat Sailing League (the BSBSL) will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), this *Notice of Race* (NOR), and the *Sailing Instructions* (SI).
- 1.2 Prescriptions of 2017-2020 US Sailing except as any of these are modified by the NOR, and by the SI (and any amendments thereto) shall apply to all boats.
- 1.3 RRS 63.7 shall be replaced by: "If there is a conflict between a rule in the Notice of Race and a rule in the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall apply"
- 1.4 The Sailing Instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at (https://yachtscoring.com/notice_board.cfm?eid=6221)

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Competitor advertising will comply with World Sailing Regulation 20.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 3.1 All races are open to all boats of a one-design class, provided no less than two (2) boats have registered for that class. A boat is considered registered after both the online registration has been completed and the entry fee has been received by the organizing authority.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at: (https://yachtscoring.com/event_registration_email.cfm?eID=6221)

4 ENTRY FEES

- 4.1 The entry fees for the BSBSL season is \$50.

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 NOR Attachment A (Schedule of Races) will apply. This can be located in "Event Documents" at: (https://yachtscoring.com/event_documents.cfm?eid=6221)
- 6.2 The scheduled time for the first warning signal of each race day will be 18:00.
- 6.3 As many races as practical will be held each race day.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 Sailing Instructions will be available after May 1st on (<https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=6221>).

6 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 6.1 For all classes, RRS 44.1, the Two-Turns Penalty, will apply to infractions of RRS 18, and for infractions of other rules, RRS 44.1, is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 Three (3) races are required to constitute a series.
- 7.2 All registered boats shall accumulate drop races at a rate of one per seven completed races.
- 7.3 A boat's series score will be the total of her scores excluding her drop races.

8 PRIZES

8.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top three boats in each class.

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

9.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10 INSURANCE

10.1 The organizing authority recommends that each competitor shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
