NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The following US Sailing prescriptions will not apply: 60, 63.2, and 63.4.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The series is open to boats holding valid ORR rating certificate that are owned, co-owned, or chartered by a Chicago Yacht Club member or pending applicant. The term "Chicago Yacht Club member" includes spouses and minor children of members of the Chicago Yacht Club. The owner, co-owner, charterer, or designated representative who is a Chicago Yacht Club member shall be aboard the boat while racing in this event.
- 2.2 A boat holding a valid ORR certificate that is owned, co-owned, or chartered by anyone other than a member of Chicago Yacht Club and holds a valid ORR certificate may compete in the ORR Offshore Program. A boat sailing under ORR will be assigned to a section according to rating and other factors at the discretion of the organizing authority.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by submitting a completed ORR Offshore #1 entry form, together with any required fee, to the Chicago Yacht Club race committee prior to the race in which the boat is entered. Entries will be accepted at the event website at www.yachtscoring.com.

3 FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee for Chicago Yacht Club members will be \$10.
- 3.2 The entry fee for a boat entering under 2.2 above will be \$50.

4 SCHEDULE AND VENUE

- 4.1 Races are scheduled on: May 19.
- 4.2 The races will be held in the open waters of Lake Michigan east of Belmont Harbor.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1130. There may be boats entered in a separate competition sailing in the same race area as this event.
- 4.4 Up to three races may be sailed.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available prior to racing on the Chicago Yacht Club website and on the official notice board at the Chicago Yacht Club Belmont Station.

6 PRIZES

Prizes will be as described in the sailing instructions.
