

2019 Lake Huron Championship Regatta

NOTICE OF RACE

Friday August 2nd to Sunday August 4th

1 RULES

- 1.1 The series races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association will apply.
- 1.3 The minimum number of crew per boat is two (2).
- 1.4 The Lake Huron PHRF By-Laws will apply and each boat shall have a current Lake Huron PHRF rating certificate.
- 1.5 The class rules as adopted by the local Cal 25 will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats shall display advertising in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20- ISAF Advertising Code.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The races are open to all boats that complete the entry form.
- 3.2 Eligible Skippers must complete registration for the series at www.yachtscoring.com website.
- 3.3 SYC yachts must also complete the SYC Registration Form.

4 FEES

- 4.1 The fee of \$50 must be paid on Yachtscoring.com when completing 3.2.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Race dates are Friday August 2nd to Sunday August 4th.
- 5.2 See Sailing Instructions for scheduled warning signal.
- 5.3 Race Registration is closed one week prior to the first race day of the regatta. Boats can request in writing to the Race Chairman to be added to the series after it is closed, each case will be reviewed case by case.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 Sailing Instructions will be available by July 29st on Yachtscoring.com event page.

7 CLASSES

- 7.1 Classes offered are PHRF and One Design.
- 7.2 Six or more boats and the approval of the Organizing Authority are required to form a class.

8 THE COURSES

- 8.1 Racing will take place in the blue waters of Lower Lake Huron 2 miles northeast of SYC harbor.
- 8.2 The courses will be windward/leeward courses using inflatable drop marks

9 SCORING

- 9.1 In accordance with RRS A2, no scores will be excluded.

10 PRIZES

- 10.1 Prizes will be given to the top three finishers in each class. Top performers will be recognized as well.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 11.1 Competitors participate in the races entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the races.

12 INSURANCE

- 12.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
