NOTICE OF RACE

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the Protest Committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Sail Canada Prescriptions will be posted on the official notice board at the Club's Boat House and can be found here: https://www.sailing.ca/files/RRS_2017_2020_Sail_Canada_Prescription_Final_EN.pdf

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all PHRF-LO rated boats with a minimum of 21' in length.
- 2.2 Participants without PHRF certificates will be assigned a temporary rating (on a best efforts basis) for the duration of the regatta at the discretion of the organizing authority.
- 2.3 Participating boats must be accompanied with a female skipper. Mixed crews are welcome.
- 2.4 Eligible boats may enter by registering on-line <https://www.yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=7293> or by submitting registration information together with the required fee, payable to Broad Reach Foundation for Youth Leaders (registered charity No. 891674525RR0001). A signed waiver form must be received prior to the close of registration.
- 2.5 All entries must be received no later than 1700 hrs on Thursday, August 8, 2019.

3 FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$113.00 CAD (\$100.00 + HST). Entry fees are tax-deductible to the fullest extent permitted by Revenue Canada.

7 THE COURSE

- 7.1 The course will be one pursuit race between five and eight nautical miles in length, west of Toronto Islands around Boulevard Club marks and/or government buoys.

8 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

- 8.1 The race committee will operate on VHF channel 72.
- 8.2 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

9 AWARDS

- 9.1 The **Martha Henderson Trophy** will be awarded to the first boat to finish.
- 9.2 The **Jilasi Philanthropy Cup** will be awarded to the boat that has raised the most funds to benefit Broad Reach Foundation for Youth Leaders.
