Notice of Race

Rules The regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. The Essex Yacht Club

strongly recommends that entrants comply with the US Safety Equipment Requirements for

Nearshore Races available at www.ussailing.org or at www.yachtscoring.com.

Eligibility The regatta is open to all boats with a valid 2019 ECSA PHRF Certificate.

Classes There will be spinnaker and non-spinnaker classes.

Entries The entry fee is \$40 per yacht (\$35 if member of USSA). Clubs are encouraged to enter at

least three boats to better compete for the Rum Challenge Club Trophy.

Entries <u>must</u> be made on the event website at <u>www.yachtscoring.com</u>. Entries must be received by 1200, Friday July 26, 2019. Late entries shall be subject to a late entry fee of

\$20.

Entrants must have a 2019 ECSA PHRF certificate posted on the ECSA website at

www.ecsa.net/PHRF/PHRFLookup.

Schedule The First Warning will be at 1200 hours. The Race Committee may decide to sail two races.

Courses The starting area will be approximately \(\frac{1}{4} \) mile west of the Old Saybrook Outer Light.

Courses will be windward-leeward with drop marks, point-to-point around government marks

or a combination of both based on weather and tide conditions.

Sailing Instructions Sailing Instructions and scratch sheets will be available at the Skipper's Meeting at Essex

Yacht Club at 1800 Friday July 26, 2019, at the event website at www.yachtscoring.com

and will be available from the Race Committee Boat prior to the First Warning.

The skipper's package, including Goslings' hats, will be available only at the Skipper's

Meeting.

Scoring Boats will be scored using PHRF Time on Time handicaps. Each boat's score for the regatta

shall be the combined total of her race scores. Ties shall be broken using the combined total

corrected time of all races sailed. This changes RRS A.8

This is an ECSA Regatta and is one of a five race series necessary to qualify for the Long

Sand Shoal Cup.

Prizes Individual prizes will be awarded to the top-placed boats in each class

The Essex Rum Challenge Club Trophy will be awarded to the yacht club with the highest

combined class scores of any three yachts using the high point scoring system. High point

scoring will be used only in scoring the Essex Rum Challenge Club Trophy.

Awards Party Prizes will be awarded at the Essex Rum Challenge Party at Essex Yacht Club following the

races. Party tickets are \$10 per person with entry or \$20 per person at the door.
