1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the current IRC Rules and the current PHRF Regulations as administered by the YRA of LIS.
- 1.2 All keelboats are required to carry a radio capable of transmitting and receiving on VHF channel 73 or as stated in the sailing instructions.
- 1.3 Sections A, B and D of Appendix T will apply as changed:
 - (i) Appendix T1 of Section A is deleted and replaced with:

The first two sentences of rule 44.1 are changed to: A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 or rule 31 while racing. However, when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 while in the zone around a mark other than a starting mark, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty.
 - (ii) Appendix T2.2 of Section B is changed as follows:
 - (a) 30%, if taken before the protest time limit and before the beginning of arbitration or a protest hearing involving the incident.

(b) 40%, if taken before the beginning of a protest hearing involving the incident.

2 ENTRIES

- 2.1 Eligible boats may enter by registering online with <http://wch.regatta.11sevent.org/> or www.yachtscoring.com or on approved entry forms received at the Larchmont Yacht Club front desk. All entries must be received no later than 1700 Friday September 6, 2013. All entries not submitted online shall be mailed to the Larchmont Yacht Club, 1 Woodbine Avenue, Larchmont, NY 10538 or faxed to 914-468-7751 Faxed entries will be accepted only with a valid signature for credit card authorization. Make checks payable to Larchmont Yacht Club.
- 2.2 The Entry Fee will include 1 ticket for the Regatta Post-Race Gala, with Silent Auction on Saturday September 7, 2013. Additional tickets \$75.00.

- 2.3 At the discretion of the race committee, divisions may be subdivided into classes.
- 2.4 The non-spinnaker division is open to boats with a PHRF rating of 50 and above. Both the Non-Spinnaker and the Double-handed divisions will be scored PHRF.
- 2.5 All handicapped entries must be submitted with their PHRF or IRC rating. IRC certificates do not need to be endorsed. Boats without a PHRF rating will be assigned a rating based upon similar boats. The rating assigned by the race committee will not be grounds for redress. This changes rule 62.1.
- 2.6 Preliminary scratch sheets listing the boats by their divisions and class will be available online or at the front desk by 1800 the day before the race and before the starting sequence from one of the committee boats.

4 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

0900-1030	Registration in the Pando for all boats racing Sunday.

1155	First Warning Optimist
1200	First Warning Optimist Green Fleet
1530	No warning signal after this time BBQ & Awards after the completion of racing.

5 START AND FINISH

The starting and finish line will be located south of the Larchmont Breakwater.

6 COURSES

The courses will be as described in the sailing instructions.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 For PHRF time allowances will be computed using time on distance.
- 7.2 For IRC the boats rating allowance will be applied as a factor of the elapsed time.

- 7.3 Boats sailing one-design level racing will be scored by class.
7.4 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores without discard.

8 PRIZES

Series prizes will be awarded to the first three finishers in each division if there are four or more entries in that division.

9 GUEST MOORINGS AND PRIVILEGES

- 9.1 Guest moorings will be available on a first come basis at no charge. Please contact the Waterfront Director at the Larchmont Yacht Club for reservations at 914-468-7756 or email: moorings@larchmontyc.org
9.2 The privileges of the Club will be extended to owners and crews of competing boats.
